

Luscious Witches Hat EASY CROCHET

Our one size fits all witches hat is sure to make a statement for your next Halloween event. Crafted from our luxurious, velvet-feel Luscious yarn, it works up quickly using simple techniques.

MEASUREMENTS

Size		One Size
To Fit Head Up To	cm	57
Measures Unstretched	cm	52
Yarn Required: Ficio Luscious	100g balls	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

CROCHET HOOK & EQUIPMENT:

A 5.00mm crochet hook OR

Size hook needed for desired size.

Black Wire or Pipe Cleaner for Brim.

Stitch Markers.

Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

14htr and 13 rows to 10cm over front post rib stitch, using 5.00mm hook.

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

ch: chain

mr: magic ring, alternatively ch4 and slip stitch to create a circle.

sl st: slip stitch

htr: half treble crochet

WITCHES HAT

NOTE: This pattern is written as a one size fits most pattern. The fit and size of the hat may be adjusted slightly by moving up or down a hook size. It's worked as a top down pattern, beginning with the point of the hat.

HAT

Crown:

Begin with mr, ch1, 6htr into magic ring ... 6htr

Round 1: Ch1, 2htr in same st, 2htr in each st around, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 12htr

Round 2: Ch1, 1htr in each st around, sl st to 2nd ch to close the round ...

Round 3: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next st, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 18htr

Round 4: As Round 2

Round 5: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 2sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 24htr

Round 6: As Round 2

Round 7: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 3sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 30htr

Round 8: As Round 2

Round 9: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 4sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 36htr

Round 10: As Round 2

Round 11: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 5sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 42htr

Round 12: As Round 2

Round 13: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 6sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 48htr

Round 14: As Round 2

Round 15: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 7sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 54htr

Round 16: As Round 2

Round 17: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 8sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 62htr

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Round 18: Ch1, 1htr in each st around, sl st to 2nd ch to close the round ...

Round 19: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 9sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 68htr

Round 20: As Round 18

Round 21: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 10sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 74htr

Shaping for the Head:

Round 22 - 23: As Round 18

Round 24: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 11sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 80htr

Round 24-27: As Round 18

Round 28: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 12sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 86htr

Round 29 - 31: As Round 18

Round 32: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 13sts, 2htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to 2nd ch to close ... 92htr

Round 33 - 35: As Round 18

Brim Shaping:

Round 36: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 3sts, 2 htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to top of starting ch to close ...

Round 37: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 4sts, 2 htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to top of starting ch to close ...

Round 38: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 5sts, 2 htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to top of starting ch to close ...

Round 39: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 6sts, 2 htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to top of starting ch to close ...

Round 40: Ch1, 2htr in same st, *1htr in next 7sts, 2 htr in next st, repeat from * until end of round, sl st to top of starting ch to close ...

Fasten Off

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. If desired, twist together lengths of like-coloured pipe cleaner to form a wire for stabilising the brim of the hat. Sew this in place using a whip stitch to the edge of the brim.
