Drop Stitch Garter Scarf

BEGINNER KNIT

Razzle Drop Stitch Scarf **BEGINNER KNIT**

The beautiful and subtle shimmer to Razzle is allowed to shine in this simple and easy-to-work pattern. Ideal for new knitters, this pattern allows you to master a new technique, the drop stitch. Basic garter stitch is bordered by three stripes of delicate drop stitch.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size		
Width	cm	25
Length (approx)	cm	160
Yarn Required: Makr Razzle	100g balls	2

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.



DIFFICULTY

KNITTING NEEDLES & EQUIPMENT:

A 3.75mm pair of needles. Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

26 sts and 40 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 3.75mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit

K2tog: Knit 2 Together

Kfb: K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide

the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle

and slide the stitch off the needle

Purl

Purl 2 Together P2tog:

Pfb: Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1 Slip One Stitch purlwise SI1: With Yarn in Front wyif: With Yarn in Back wyib:

ssk: Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)

SCARF

Casting On:

Cast on 65 sts, begin working in garter stitch, knitting every row, until piece measures 10cm from the beginning.

Dropped Stitch Border:

Row 1: *Ins RN into the first st knitwise, YO three times, pull through as if you were knitting a st normally, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 2: Knit all the stitches normally, releasing the wrapped stitches as you

Row 3 -8: Knit all sts.

Row 9: *Ins RN into the first st knitwise, YO twice, pull through as if you were knitting a st normally, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 10: Knit all the stitches normally, releasing the wrapped stitches as you

Row 11 -19: Knit all sts.

Row 20: *Ins RN into the first st knitwise, YO three times, pull through as if you were knitting a st normally, repeat from * to end of row.

Row 21: Knit all the stitches normally, releasing the wrapped stitches as you

Main Scarf Panel:

Work in garter stitch until piece measures 140cm from the beginning.

Repeat the dropped stitch border section to match the other end of the scarf.

Work in garter stitch again until piece measures 10cm from the end of the last drop stitch section worked. Cast off in knit.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and stretch gently into shape.
