Seed Stitch Knot Bag

EASY KNIT

Our bright and fun Harlequin yarn comes to life in this pebbly, textured seed stitch. Inspired by Japanese knot bags, this small purse features a single hand and loop style fastening.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size		
Circumference	cm	36
Height (w/o Handle)	cm	18
Yarn Required: Makr Harlequin	100g balls	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

ITEM A: Bag Flatlay



DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 5.50mm knitting needles, 80cm
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

12 sts and 21 rows to 10cm over seed stitch, using 5.50mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K:	Knit
K2tog:	Knit 2 Together
Kfb:	K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle and slide the stitch off the needle
P:	Purl
P2tog:	Purl 2 Together
Pfb:	Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1
Sl1:	Slip One Stitch purlwise
wyif:	With Yarn in Front
wyib:	With Yarn in Back
ssk:	Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)

KNOT BAG

Base:

Using a set of 5.50mm needles, cast on 46 sts. Join into the round being careful not to twist cast on edge.

Round 1: *K1, P1, repeat from * to end of round.

Round 2: *P1, K1, repeat from * to end of round.

These two rounds form a seed stitch pattern, continue in this pattern until work measures 18cm from beg ending with a Round 2.

Handle:

Row 1: Sl1, *P1, K1 repeat from * 5 more times ... 13 sts

Using a pair of 5.50mm needles, continue working on these 13 sts only for the handle. Repeating Row 1 until handle measures 30cm ending with a WS row.

Graft these 13 sts to the next 13 sts still on your circular needles.

Loop Closure:

With right side facing and using a pair of 4.00mm needles, knit next 10 sts, turn. Continue on these 13 sts for the loop closure.

Row 1: Sl1, *P1, K1 repeat from * 5 more times ... 10 sts

Repeat Row 1 until loop measures 14cm, ending with a WS row.

Graft these 10 sts to the remaining 10 sts on the needles, taking care not to twist when joining.

FINISHING

Lie the Bag flat with the Loop Closure in front of the Handle, then using a length of yarn, sew the bottom seam together. Sew in all ends. Pass the loop closure over the handle to close the bag.
