Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## DIFFICULTY •

## NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 4.00 mm knitting needles, 30 cm Wool needle for sewing in ends.

## TENSION:

22 sts and 28 rows stocking stitch using 4 mm needles

## KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

| C | Colour |
| :--- | :--- |
| K: | knit |
| K2tog | k 2 sts tog |
| P: | purl |
| St(s) | stitch(es) |
| STST | stocking stitch (alternate $k$ and $p$ row) |
| TOG | together |

## EGG COSIE

Notes: Using 2 colours without cutting ends to change colour. Each colour is worked for 2 rows at a time. When changing colours at the start of a row, take thread from previous row end to start knitting with, allowing a little bit of slack so the edge of the knitting doesn't pucker.

Using 4mm knitting needles, and long tail cast on method, cast on 30 sts.

Row 1-2. Knit row using C1.
Row 3. *Change to C2: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 4. Prow.
Row 5. Change to C 1 : work 2 rows stst (k 1 row/ p1 row).*
Row 6. Repeat from * to * (row 3 to row 6), until 3 sts remain, and up to row 56.
Row 56. K 3sts together.

Leave a 20 cm thread of one colour for sewing up.

## FINISHING

With wrong side facing, sew the two edge seams together. Sew loose threads into seams to hide neatly. Turn inside out so the right side is facing.

## TASSEL

Cut a 60 cm thread of C3. Using a blunt darning needle, thread yarn through the tip of the egg cosie. Leave 5 cm loops of thread with each passing through of the needle thread, ecuring with small stitch each time. Cut last thread and trim ends of all 6 threads.
