

Knitted on the bias from the point to the tail, this tie would make a beautiful gift for a groom-to-be. This tie is worked up in a delicate seed stitch and seamed together to create a skinny-styled tie.

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Width (approx)	cm	13
Finished Length (approx)	cm	170
Yarn Required: Makr Razzle	100g balls	1

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

ITEM A: Seed Stitch Detailing



DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles. Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

26 sts and 48 rows to 10cm over seed st, using 3.25mm needles.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit

K2tog: Knit 2 Together

Kfb: K1 into the fr of the next stitch on the needle but do not slide

the stitch off, K1 into the bk of the same stitch on the needle

and slide the stitch off the needle

Purl

Purl 2 Together P2tog:

Pfb: Purl 1, Purl tbl to increase by 1 Slip One Stitch purlwise SI1: With Yarn in Front wyif:

With Yarn in Back wyib:

ssk: Slip, Slip Knit (Left Slanting Decrease)

Forming the Point:

Using 3.25mm needles and a long tail cast on method, cast on 35 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Sl1, *K1, P1, repeat from * to end of row. Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 1 & 2 form a seed stitch pattern.

Increase by 1 stitch at the end of each RS row until there are 62 sts. Taking care to add the sts into the pattern correctly. Work one more wrong side row.

Tapering the Sides:

Next Row (RS): Patt1, K2tog, work in pattern established to last st, YO,

Next Row: Work in pattern to last three sts, P2tog, Patt1. Repeat the above two rows until 33 sts remain.

Working Straight:

Next Row: Patt1, K2tog, work in pattern established to last st, YO, Patt1. Next Row: Work in pattern established.

Continue repeating the above two rows until piece measures 140cm from the beginning, measuring from the tip of the point down the centre line, ending with a WS row.

Next Row (RS): Patt1, K2tog, work in pattern established to last st, YO,

Next Row: Patt2, YO, work in pattern to end.

Next Row: Patt1, K2tog, work in pattern established to end.

Next Row: Work in pattern established to end. Repeat the above two rows until 20 sts remain, cast off.

Finish by weaving ends in, fold lengthwise and seam from tip to tail end.
