

Crafted from our incredibly soft and snug Cuddles yarn, this bunny is the perfect present for a newborn or a great alternative to giving a child chocolate for Easter. Knitted flat and seamed together, Georgie the bunny is a great pattern for first time toy knitters to sink their teeth into.

## MEASUREMENTS

| Yarn Required: <br> Makr Cuddles (M) | 100 g balls | 3 |
| Makr Cuddles (C1) | 100 g balls | 1 |

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## DIFFICULTY ••

## NEEDLES \& EQUIPMENT:

A pair of 3.50 mm knitting needles. Optional: A 4.00 mm crochet hook. Stitch Markers
Wool needle for sewing in ends.
Small amount of brown yarn for face.
Tapestry Needles.
Stuffing.
Optional: A short length of dowel for neck.
Optional: Safety eyes.

## TENSION:

23.5 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm over stocking st, using 3.50 mm needles.

## KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: knit
K2tog: knit two stitches together, right slanting decrease
Kfb: knit front back
SSK: $\quad$ slip, slip, knit, left slanting decrease
P: purl
P2tog: purl two stitches together, right slanting decrease
P2togtb: purl two stitches together through the back loop.
SI1: $\quad$ slip one stitch purl-wise
PSSO: pass slip stitch over

## HEAD

Right Side:
Using 3.50 mm needles and $M$, cast on 20 sts.
Work in stocking stitch for 4 rows.
Row 5 (RS): K2, Kfb twice, knit to end of row .. 22 sts.
Work in stocking stitch for 3 rows.
Row 9: K2, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K12, Kfb, K1, Kfb, K2 ... 26 sts***
Work in stocking stitch for 2 rows.
Row 12: Cast on 4 sts at the beginning of the row and purl to end ... 30 sts Work in stocking stitch for 3 rows.
Row 16: Cast on 4 sts at the beginning of the row and purl to end ... 34 sts Work in stocking stitch for 1 rows.
Row 18: P2, Pfb, Purl to end ... 35 sts
Row 19: K2, Kfb, knit to last three sts, Kfb, K2 ... 37 sts
Row 20: P2, Pfb, purl to last three sts, Pfb, P2 ... 39 sts
Work in stocking stitch for 2 rows.
Row 23: Knit to last three sts, Kfb, K2 ... 40 sts
Work in stocking stitch for 11 rows, placing a marker at the end of the last row.
Row 36: Cast off 12 sts, purl to end.
Row 37: K2, SSK, knit to four stitches before end, K2tog, K2.
Work 3 rows stocking st.
Repeat these four rows until 16 sts remain. Cast off.
Left Side:
Work as for the Right Side Head until ${ }^{* * *}$
Work in stocking stitch for 1 row.
Row 11: Cast on 4 sts at the beginning of the row and knit to end ... 30 sts Work in stocking stitch for 3 rows.
Row 15: Cast on 4 sts at the beginning of the row and knit to end ... 34 sts Work in stocking stitch for 2 rows.

Row 18: Purl to last three sts, Pfb, P2 ... 35 sts
Row 19: K2, Kfb, knit to last three sts, Kfb, K2 ... 37 sts
Row 20: P2, Pfb, purl to last three sts, Pfb, P2 ... 39 sts Work in stocking stitch for 2 rows.
Row 23: K2, Kfb, knit to end ... 40 sts
Work in stocking stitch for 12 rows, placing a marker at the end of the last row.
Row 35: Cast off 12 sts, knit to end.
Work one row stocking st.
Row 37: K2, SSK, knit to four stitches before end, K2tog, K2.
Work 3 rows stocking st.
Repeat these four rows until 16 sts remain. Cast off.
Gusset:
Cast on 11 sts.
Working in stocking st, increase by one st at each end of the 20th row and every following 12 th row until there are 29 sts.

Work 10 rows stocking st even.
Decrease one st at each end of the next row and every 4th row until 11 sts remain.

Work 8 rows stocking st even.
Decrease one st at each end of next row.
Work one row.
Decrease one st at each end of next row ... 5 sts
Work 2 rows stocking st and cast off.
BODY (MAKE TWO ALIKE)
Shoulders:
Using $M$ and 3.50 mm needles, cast on 14 sts.
Working in stocking stitch, beginning with a knit row, cast on 2 sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows ... 18 sts.

Begin to increase by one st at each end of every row until there are 32 sts. Work one row stocking st.

Continue to increase on every alt row now until there are 48 sts , from here work straight without further increases until piece measures 25 cm from the beginning ending with a WS row.

Bottom Shaping:
Row 1 (RS): K2, SSK, K18, K2tog, SSK, K18, K2tog, K2 ... 44 sts
Row 2: P2, P2tog, P16, P2togtbl, P2tog, K16, P2togtbl, K2 ... 40 sts.
Row 3: K2, SSK, K14, K2tog, SSK, K14, K2tog, K2 ... 36 sts
Row 4: P2, P2tog, P12, P2togtbl, P2tog, P12, P2togtbl, K2 ... 32 sts
Row 5: K2, SSK, K10, K2tog, SSK, K10, K2tog, K2 ... 28 sts
Row 6: P2, P2tog, P8, P2togtbl, P2tog, P8, P2togtbl, K2 ... 24 sts
Row 7: K2, SSK, K6, K2tog, SSK, K6, K2tog, K2 ... 20 sts
Row 8: P2, P2tog, P4, P2togtbl, P2tog, P4, P2togtbl, K2 ... 16 sts
Row 9: K2, SSK, K2, K2tog, SSK, K2, K2tog, K2 ... 12 sts
Row 10: P2, P2tog, P2togtbl, P2tog, P2togtbl, K2 ... 8 sts
Row 11: K2, SSK, K2tog, K2 ... 6 sts
Cast off remaining stitches purl-wise.

## EARS

Outer Piece (Make two alike):

Using $M$ and 3.50 mm needles, cast on 14 sts.
Begin to work in stocking st increasing by one st at each end of the fifth row and each fourth row following until there are 36 sts.

Work even until piece measures 19 cm from the beginning.
Decrease by one stitch at each end of every alt row until 26 sts rem, then decrease by one stitch at each end of every row until 6 sts rem.

Cast off remaining sts.
Inner Piece (Make two alike):
Using C1 and 3.50 mm needles cast on 10 sts.
Begin to work in stocking st increasing by one st at each end of the fifth row and each fourth row following until there are 32 sts.

Work even until piece measures 18 cm from the beginning.
Decrease by one stitch at each end of every alt row until 22 sts rem, then decrease by one stitch at each end of every row until 4 sts rem.

Cast off remaining sts.
LEGS (MAKE TWO ALIKE)

## Sole:

Using 3.50 mm needles and M , cast on 15 sts
Work in garter st for 28 rows.
Cast on 28 sts at the beg of the next two rows ... 71 sts
Work in stocking st for 10 rows.
Decrease one st at ea end of the next 10 rows ... 51 sts
Work in stocking st without further shaping for 20 more rows.
Hip Shaping:
Next Row: P11, P2togtbl, P2tog, P21, P2tog, P2togtbl, P11 ... 47 sts
Next Row: K10, SSK, K2tog, K19, K2tog, SSK, K10 ... 43 sts
Next Row: P9, P2togtbl, P2tog, P17, P2tog, P2togtbl, P9 ... 39 sts
Next Row: K8, SSK, K2tog, K15, K2tog, SSK, K8 ... 35 sts
Next Row: P7, P2togtbl, P2tog, P13, P2tog, P2togtbl, P7 ... 31 sts
ITEM A: Pieces Required


## Cuddles Georgie the Bunny

Next Row: K6, SSK, K2tog, K11, K2tog, SSK, K6 ... 27 sts Next Row: P5, P2togtbl, P2tog, P9, P2tog, P2togtbl, P5 ... 23 sts Next Row: K4, SSK, K2tog, K7, K2tog, SSK, K4 ... 19 sts
Next Row: P3, P2togtbl, P2tog, P5, P2tog, P2togtbl, P3 ... 15 sts
Next Row: K2, SSK, K2tog, K3, K2tog, SSK, K2 ... 11 sts
Next Row: P1, P2togtbl, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P2togtbl, P1 ... 7 sts
Next Row: SSK, Sl1, K2tog, PSSO, K2tog ... 3 sts
Cast off remaining sts.
ARMS (MAKE TWO ALIKE)
Casting On:
Using $M$ and 3.50 mm needles, cast on 6 sts
Row 1: Kfb, 6 times ... 12 sts

Work one row stocking st
Row 3: Kfb 12 times ... 24 sts
Work one row stocking st
Row 5: Kfb, K1 ... 36 sts
Work one row stocking st
Row 7: *Kfb, K3, repeat from * to end of row ... 45 sts
Work in stocking st for 31 rows.
Shaping the Arm Socket:
Row 39: K10, K2tog, SSK, K17, K2tog, SSK, K10 ... 41 sts
Row 40: P9, P2togtbl, P2tog, P15, P2togtbl, P2tog, P9 ... 37 sts
Row 41: K8, K2tog, SSK, K13, K2tog, SSK, K8 ... 33 sts
Row 42: P7, P2togtbl, P2tog, P11, P2togbl, P2tog, P7 ... 29 sts

ITEM B: Assembly of the bunny


Row 43: K6, K2tog, SSK, K9, K2tog, SSK, K6 ... 25 sts
Row 44: P5, P2togtbl, P2tog, P7, P2togtbl, P2tog, P5 ... 21 sts
Row 45: K4, K2tog, SSK, K5, K2tog, SSK, K4 ... 17 sts
Row 46: P3, P2togtbl, P2tog, P3, P2togtbl, P2tog, P3 ... 13 sts
Row 47: K2, K2tog, SSK, K1, K2tog, SSK, K2 ... 9 sts
Row 48: P2togtbl, P2tog, P1, P2togtbl, P2tog ... 5 sts
Row 49: K2tog, K1, K2togtbl ... 3 sts
Cast off remaining stitches and fasten off.

## FINISHING

List of Parts:
Upon completing your knitting double check that you have all the parts listed below handy:

- Left and Right Head Pieces
- Head Gusset
- $2 \times$ Arms
- $2 \times$ Legs
- $2 \times$ Outer Ear Pieces
- $2 x$ Inner Ear Pieces


## Assembly:

Join together, using mattress stitch or a crochet chain stitch, the two body pieces, leaving the cast on edges open for stuffing, Turn right side out and fill with stuffing taking care not to overfill as your bunny will become hard and the stuffing may poke through.

Sew the head piece to each side of the head gusset, taking care to join them symmetrically. If using safety eyes, fix in place now. Place the cast on edges at the base of the head and note the gusset finishes before the markers, this marks the bears nose. The cast on edge for the gusset forms part of the nose. Seam together under the nose. Stuff the head as well and join to body, using the dowel to stabilize the neck if necessary.

Seam arms and legs together, leaving an opening for the stuffing. Turn right side out and fill with stuffing. Close securely, attaching the legs and arms to the body.

With RS together, join outer edges of inner and outer ears, leaving the cast on seam unstitched. Turn right side out and sew in position along head gusset seam, taking care that the ears are balanced and symmetrical.

Embroider eyes and nose using yarn as shown in images.
