FICIO ORGANIC COTTON Crochet Bucket Hat

EASY CROCHET

## **DESCRIPTION**

Bucket hats are super cute and popular right now so here's a fun crochet hat with a granny square style circle top and filet crochet style flower lower section with no sewing!

**MEASUREMENTS** 

One size only: Will fit a standard size adult head approx 52 cm

Length: 22 cm Width: 32 cm

## **YARN REQUIRED**

Ficio Organic Cotton

Colour 1 C1: White 1 ball Colour 2 C2: Orchid 1 ball Colour 3 C3

: Slate Blue 1 ball

(Lincraft Recycled Cotton or the Makr 8 ply cotton can also be used. The main colour used will need 2 balls, and contrast 1 ball each. If you wish to use 4 ply cotton yarn, the hat will be smaller and can fit a child's head)

## **CROCHET HOOK AND EQUIPMENT**

3.00mm hook and 2.5 mm hook (tension is deliberately tight to make the hat stiffer)

Scissors

Tapestry needle







#### **TENSION**

10 cm x 10 cm = 20 sts x 10 rows

## **CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS**

blo: back loop only

ch: chain

dc: double crochet dec decrease

**sk:** skip

sl st: slip stitch

**sp:** space **tr:** treble

**yrh:** yarn round hook

#### **NOTES**

Dec 1 : yrh, draw loop through next straw loop through 2 loops on hook, yrh, draw loop through next st, draw loop through 2 loops on hook, draw loop through 3 loops on hook.

If using only one colour, ignore the colour changing instructions (e.g. C1 fasten off etc)

## **GRANNY FILET BUCKET HAT INSTRUCTIONS**

Using a 3.00 mm crochet hook, ch 5, sl st to join into a ring.

**ROUND 1:** Dc 12 into ring, sl st into first st to join, fasten off C1

**ROUND 2:** Join C2, ch 1, dc 11 into blo, sl st into first st to join (12 sts)

**ROUND 3**: Ch 5, working into blo \* tr 1, ch 2\* repeat from \*

to \* 10 times, sl st into third ch of initial ch 5 to join, fasten off. Count to make sure you have 12 x ch 2 sps

**ROUND 4:** Join C3 by working a sl st into first ch 2 sp, ch3, tr3 but only work half the tr, so 4 sts left on hook, pull through all sts, ch 1 to close cluster, then ch 3.

After first cluster, work tr 4 clusters, working in the same manner, work 4 x

incomplete trebles with 5 sts remaining on hook, pull through all sts, ch 1 to finish cluster, then ch 3 between clusters.  $12 \times tr 4$  clusters, fasten off C3

**ROUND 5:** Join C1 and sl st into first ch 3 sp, ch 3, tr 2 \* tr 1 into cluster from previous row, tr 3 into next ch sp \* repeat until end of round, sl st to join, fasten off C1. 48 sts (including initial ch 3 as 1 st)

**ROUND 6:** Join C3, ch 3, \*tr 3, tr 2 into next st\* repeat from \* to \* till end of round, sl st into 3rd ch of initial ch 3 to join, fasten off C3, 60 sts.

**ROUND 7:** Join C 2, ch 3, \*tr 4, tr 2 into next st\* repeat from \* to \* till end of round, sl st into 3rd ch of initial ch 3. 72 sts.

**ROUND 8:** Ch 3, \*tr 5, tr 2 into next st\* repeat from \* to \* till the last 11 sts, then tr 11 till end, sl st into 3rd ch of initial ch 3. 80 sts.

**ROUND 9:** Ch 3, \* tr 7, ( tr 1, ch 1, tr 1 ) into same st \* repeat from \* to \* till end, sk 1, sl st into 3rd ch of ch 3, sts. 10 x (tr 1, ch 1, tr 1)

**ROUND 10:** Ch 3, tr 6, dec 1 (see note) ch 3 \* miss 1 ch (between 2 tr from previous round), dec 1, tr 5, dec 1, ch 3 \* repeat from \* to \* to end join with sl st as previous rounds.

**ROUND 11:** Ch 3, tr 4, dec 1, ch 2, tr 1 in ch sp, ch 2 \* dec 1, tr 3, dec 1, ch 2, tr 1 in ch sp, ch 2 \* rep from \* to \* till end.

**ROUND 12:** Ch 3, tr 1 in each of next 2 sts, dec 1(ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) twice, ch 2 \* dec 1, tr 1, dec 1 (ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) twice, ch 2 \* repeat from \* to \* till end.

**ROUND 13:** Ch 3, tr 1 in next 2 sts (ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) 3 times, ch 2 \* dec 1, tr in next st, (ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) 3 times, ch 2 \* repeat from \* to \* till end.

**ROUND 14:** Ch 3, tr 1 in next st, (ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) 4 times, ch 2, \* dec 1 (ch 2, tr 1 in next ch sp) 4 times, ch 2 \* repeat from \* to \* till end.

**ROUND 15:** SI st in 1st ch sp, ch 5 \* tr 1 in next ch sp, ch 2\* repeat from \* to \* till end

**ROUND 16:** Same as round 15 Change to 2.50 mm hook

**ROUND 17 - 19:** Work 3 rounds of dc, in the first row working 1 dc into each ch sp and 1 dc into each tr.

## **WORK BRIM**

**ROUND 20:** Ch 2 tr 2, 2 tr in next st \* tr 3, 2 tr in next st \* repeat from \* to \* to end.

**ROUND 21:** Ch 2, tr 4, 2 tr in next st, \* tr 6, 2 tr in next st\* repeat from \* to \* till end.

**ROUND 22:** Ch 3, tr 3, 2 tr in next st \* tr 8, 2 tr in next st\* repeat from \* to \* till end.

Fasten off with an invisible join after this round if you like a short brim on your hat.

**ROUND 22:** Ch 3, tr 3, 2 tr in next st \* tr 10, 2 tr in next st \* repeat from \* to \* till end, join round with an invisible join, fasten off.

## **FINISHING AND CARE**

You can finish as previous row and leave the brim plain, or alternatively you can replace round 24 with the following row for a ruffle finish.

Alternative last row In a contrasting colour tr 2 into each st, fasten off. Weave in ends. Block.
