MAKR DK 8 PLY ACRYLIC

Pumpkin Garland

EASY CROCHET

NOTE: This pattern is written in UK terms.

MEASUREMENTS (PER PUMPKIN)

Height	5cm
Width	7cm

YARN REQUIREMENTS (PER PUMPKIN):

Makr DK 'Bottle'	7g or 17.5m 1g or <2.5m per leaf Extra for vine
Makr DK 'Gold'	7g or 17.5m
Makr DK 'Claret'	7g or 17.5m
Makr DK 'Fire Red'	7g or 17.5m

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as crochet styles may vary between crocheters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

CROCHET HOOK & EQUIPMENT:

4mm crochet hook Poly Fill

Scissors

Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

Using a 4mm hook. 19 dc x 21 rows = 10cm x 10cm

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

ch: chain

double crochet dc:

sk: skip st: stitch blo: back loop only half treble htr: treble tr: dtr: double treble sl st: slip stitch

PUMPKIN

Using a 4mm hook, ch 16.

Row 1: sk first ch, 1 dc in each ch. ch 1, turn. (15)

Row 2 - 28: (in blo) 1 dc in each st. ch 1, turn.

Do not fasten off.

SEAMING AND CLOSURE

Fold work in half (short sides together), and sl st through both layers to seam.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail.

Using long tail and a darning needle thread yarn in and out all the way around the long edge to create a drawstring. Once you read the beginning pull to close and secure.

Turn work right right side out. Fill pumpkin with poly fill and repeat the above process to close opposite end.

LEAF

Using 4mm hook, ch 2.

sk first ch. In second ch from hook complete dc, htr, tr, dtr, tr, htr, dc. SI st into first dc to join.

VINE

Using 4mm hook and 'Bottle' yarn, ch required amount of stitches to achieve desired length.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends.

Using your darning needle, thread vine through the top of each pumpkin

Hang and enjoy!
