Chic Beanie

EASY KNIT

This 'Chic' Beanie is made in one piece with a seam, and knitted with 2 strands of yarn and big needles. Easy to knit petal shapes are attached for embellishment.

This is quick and fun creative project for beginner knitters, and the petals can be made in any colour combination with as many petals as you like. The metallic glitter in this SPIRIT GLITTER yarn is what makes this beanie so 'chic', but you could also go even further and add some Lincraft sequence and beads ... even a mesh veil for some extra glamour!

#### MEASUREMENTS

One Size:

Circumference	58cm at bottom
Height	28cm

Yarn Required:

Light Beanie

Makr Spirit Glitter 170g ball C1 Main Colour: Doeskin (1 strand)  
C2 Main Colour: DustyPink (1 strand)

Petals 170g ball C3 Black  
C4 Green/Celadon  
C5 Brown/Doeskin  
C6 Grey

Dark Beanie

Makr Spirit Glitter 170g ball C3 Main Colour:  
Black (2 strands)

Petals 170g ball C2 Pink/Dusty Pink  
C3 Black  
C4 Green/Celadon  
C5 Brown/Doeskin

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

#### NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 15mm knitting needles, 30cm.  
1 pair of 10mm knitting needles, 30cm  
1 pair of 5mm knitting needles, 30cm  
Wool needle for sewing in ends.  
Pins for positioning petals onto beanie.

#### TENSION:

16 sts and 27 rows plain knit stitch using 5mm needles.  
11 sts and 15 rows plain knit using 15mm needles and 2 strands of yarn.

#### KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K: knit  
K2tog k 2 sts tog  
P: purl  
St(s) stitch(es)  
TOG together

#### NOTES:

Use 2 strands of main colour yarn for beanie. For the light colour beanie, mix 1 strand each of the main colours.

#### BEANIE PATTERN

Using 15mm knitting needles, and 2 strands of yarn, and long tail cast on method, cast on 40 sts.

Row 1: K.  
Row 2: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.  
Row 3: Repeat Row 1 and Row 2, until 10 sts remain.

Cast off loosely.  
Leave a 40cm thread for sewing up.

#### PETALS

You can make these petal shapes in any colour mix you like, but follow the colour guide if you'd like to follow the suggested arrangement for the light and dark colour beanie.



## PETALS

## PETAL 1

Light Beanie: C2, C3; Dark Beanie C4 (make 2)

5mm knitting needles.

Row 1. Cast on 2 sts.

Row 2. K row.

Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)

Row 4. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)

Row 5. K1, k into b/f of st, k to last 2 sts, k into b/f of st, k1.

Row 6-8. Repeat row 4 until 12 sts.

Row 9-12. K row

Row 13. K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (10sts)

Row 14-16. Repeat row 13 until 3 sts remain

Row 17. K 3 sts tog.

Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

## PETAL 2

Light Beanie: C4, C6; Dark Beanie C4 (make 2)

5mm knitting needles.

Row 1. Cast on 2sts.

Row 2. K row

Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)

Row 4. K row

Row 5. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)

Row 6. K row

Row 7. K1, k into b/f of st, k to last 2 sts, k into b/f of st, k1. (8 sts)

Row 8-16. K row

Row 17. K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (6sts)

Row 18. K row

Row 19. K1, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)

Row 20. K row

Row 21. K1, k2tog, k1. (3 sts)

Row 22. K row.

Row 23. K 3sts tog.

Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

## PETAL 3

Light Beanie and Dark Beanie C5 (make 2 for each beanie)

5mm knitting needles.

Row 1. Cast on 2 sts

Row 2. K row

Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)

Row 4. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)

Row 5. K row.

Row 6. K1, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)

Row 7. K1, k2tog, k1. (3 sts)

Row 8. K3 sts tog.

Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

## PETAL 4

Light Beanie C4; Dark Beanie C2

12mm knitting needles.

Row 1. With 2 strands of yarn cast on 2 sts.

Row 2. K row.

Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)

Row 4. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)

Row 5. K1, k into st winding thread three times around the needle. Repeat to last st. K1.

Row 6. K1. P st letting extra loops drop off needle.

Repeat to last st. K1.

Row 7. K1, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)

Row 8. K1, k2tog, k1. (3 sts)

Row 9. K3 sts tog.

Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

## PETAL BUD.

Light Beanie C2, Dark Beanie C3

12mm knitting needles

Row 1. Cast on 5 sts.

Row 2. P5 sts tog.

Draw thread through last st to secure.

Sew in loose threads to neaten.

## FINISHING

With wrong side facing, fold the knitting in half, sew the flat cast off seam edges together, and continue down the edge seams. Sew loose threads into seams to hide neatly. Turn inside out so the sewing faces inside the beanie.

## PETALS

Sew loose threads into edges of petals to hide neatly.

Arrange and position the petals onto the beanie. Pin, and sew to fasten. Sew loose threads into seams to hide neatly.
