Rosebud Bag

INTERMEDIATE KNIT

This little fancy bag is made in a lace stitch in one piece, joined with a seam, and attached handle with 'easy to knit' petal shapes for extra embellishment.

The lace stitch is a combination of knitting 5 stitches together, then reconstituting those stitches by working into the next stitch 5 times. This creates raised bobble effects. In-between these bobble rows, extra yarn is wound onto the thread when knitting, and then dropped when purling; elongating the stitches into long wavy strands, creating a beautiful textural effect, which really 'shows off' this SPIRIT GLITTER yarn.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size

Circumference	40cm
Height	28cm
(with handles)	48cm

Yarn Required:

Makr Spirit Glitter 170 g balls 1

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 5.00mm knitting needles, 30cm.
1 pair of 10mm knitting needles, 30cm
Wool needle for sewing in ends.
Pins for positioning petals onto bag.

TENSION:

16 sts and 27 rows plain knit stitch using 5mm needles.
11 sts and 15 rows plain knit using 10mm needles and 2 strands of yarn.

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

B/F: back and front
K: knit
K2tog k 2 sts tog
P: purl
St(s) stitch(es)
TOG together

NOTES

The bag is knitted with 2 strands of yarn and 10mm needles in a lace stitch, changing to 1 strand of yarn and 5mm needles to knit the top band (width) in a plain knit stitch. Pull one strand from inside the Spirit Glitter yarn ball, and one from the outside to make the 2 strands of yarn.

BAG PATTERN

Using 2 strands of yarn and 10mm knitting needles, long tail cast on 52 sts.

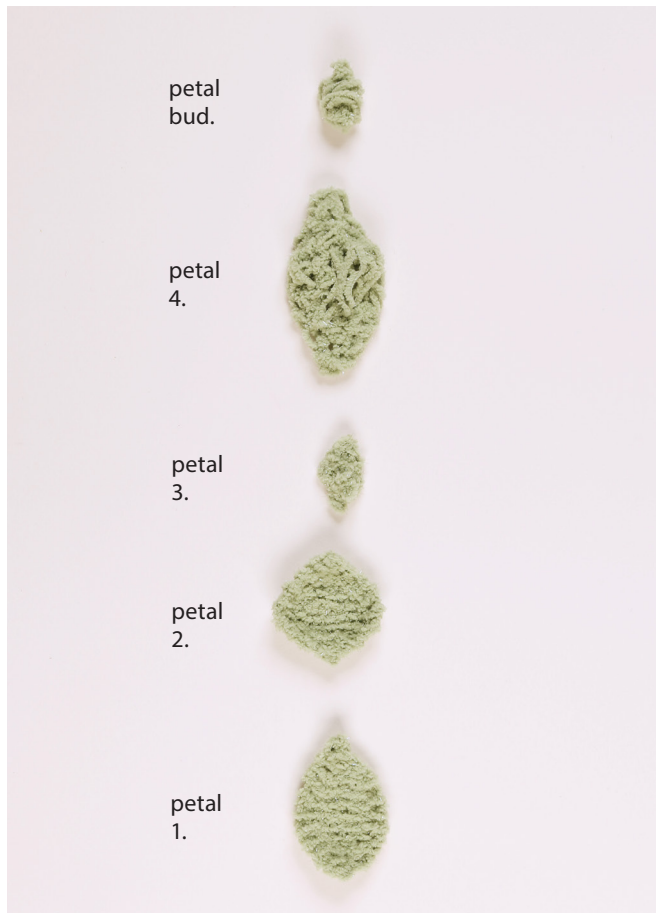
Row 1: (wrong side of work) K2, *p 5 tog. (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) into next st*, repeat * to * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 2: P.
Row 3: K2, *(k1, p1, k1, p1, k1) into next st, p 5 tog. *, repeat * to * to last 2 sts, k2.
Row 4: K2, k winding the thread 3 times round needle for each st, until last 2 sts, k2.
Row 5: K2, p letting the extra loops drop off needle, until last 2 sts, k2.
Row 6-20: Repeat rows 1 – 5.

Change to 1 strand of yarn and 5mm knitting needles.

Row 21-36:K
Cast off loosely.
Leave a 40cm thread for sewing up.

HANDLES

Cast on 12 sts with 5mm needles and 1 strand of yarn.
Row 1-100 K.
Cast off.



PETAL PATTERNS

PETAL 1

Make 2

5mm knitting needles, 1 strand of yarn.

- Row 1. Cast on 2 sts.
 Row 2. K row.
 Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)
 Row 4. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)
 Row 5. K1, k into b/f of st, k to last 2 sts, k into b/f of st, k1.
 Row 6-8. Repeat row 4 until 12 sts.
 Row 9-12. K row
 Row 13. K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (10sts)
 Row 14-16. Repeat row 13 until 3 sts remain
 Row 17. K 3 sts tog.
 Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

PETAL 2

Make 2

5mm knitting needles, 1 strand of yarn

- Row 1. Cast on 2sts.
 Row 2. K row
 Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)
 Row 4. K row
 Row 5. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)
 Row 6. K row
 Row 7. K1, k into b/f of st, k to last 2 sts, k into b/f of st, k1. (8 sts)
 Row 8-16. K row
 Row 17. K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (6sts)
 Row 18. K row
 Row 19. K1, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)
 Row 20. K row
 Row 21. K1, k2tog, k1. (3 sts)
 Row 22. K row.
 Row 23. K 3sts tog.
 Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

PETAL 4

Make 1

12mm knitting needles.

- Row 1. With 2 strands of yarn cast on 2 sts.
 Row 2. K row.
 Row 3. K into b/f of each stitch (4 sts)
 Row 4. K1, k into b/f of next two stitches, K1 (6 sts)
 Row 5. K1, k into st winding thread three times around the needle. Repeat to last st. K1.
 Row 6. K1. P st letting extra loops drop off needle. Repeat to last st. K1.
 Row 7. K1, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)
 Row 8. K1, k2tog, k1. (3 sts)
 Row 9. K3 sts tog.
 Draw thread through last stitch to secure.

PETAL BUD

Petal Bud.

Make 2

12mm knitting needles

- Row 1. Cast on 5 sts.
 Row 2. P5 sts tog.
 Draw thread through last st to secure.
 Sew in loose threads to neaten.

FINISHING

With wrong side facing, fold the knitting in half, sew seam edges together. Sew loose threads into seams to hide neatly. Turn inside out so the right side is facing.

FINISHING

Sew loose threads into edges of petals to hide neatly. Arrange and position the petals onto top edge of the bag. Pin, and sew to fasten. Sew handle to each side of bag.
