# Lincraft Shrug #P317 **EASYKNIT** MAKR SPIRIT GLITTER

This shrug is knitted in one piece in an easy knit stitch, and is a great project for beginners; but is a substantial knitting work-out to also appeal to more experienced knitters. It has a fitted long slim sleeve, which expands into a scarf width by knitting into each stitch twice. Enough length is worked in the scarf so it can wrap around the neck and shoulders, and extend into the other sleeve. The metallic speck in this SPIRIT GLITTER yarn makes this garment a bit fancy, but also so soft and cosy; this shrug is like wearing a hug.

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

# DIFFICULTY • • •

## **NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:**

A pair of 5.00mm knitting needles, 35cm. Wool needle for sewing in ends.

### **TENSION:**

16 sts and 27 rows plain knit stitch using 5mm needles.

### **KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:**

B/F: back and front

K: knit
K2tog k 2 sts tog
P: purl
St(s) stitch(es)

STST stocking stitch (alternate k and p row)

TOG together

### **SHRUG PATTERN**

Using 5mm knitting needles, and long tail cast on method, cast on 35 (46, 50) sts.

Leave a 35cm thread for sewing up sleeves later.

Makes Sleeve:

Row 1-88 (99, 105): K.

The knitting now expands into a scarf width:

Row 88 (99, 105): K 2 (8, 10), K into b/f of next 31 (30,

30) sts, K 2 (8, 10) sts, total 66 (76, 80) sts.)

Row 89 (100, 106) to

Row 381 (401, 425) K.

The knitting now reduces to sleeve width again:

Row 381 (401, 425): K 2 (8, 10), K2tog for next 31 (30,

30) sts, K2 (5, 8, 10) sts, total 35 (46, 50) sts.

Other Sleeve:

Row 382 (402, 426) to Row 470 (501, 530): K.

Cast off with k1/p1 rib stitch, which creates extra stretch for the sleeve opening.

Leave a 35cm thread for sewing up.

### FINISHING

Sew the sleeve seams together. Sew loose threads into seams to hide neatly. Turn inside out so the sewing is facing the inside.
