Scarf \& Beanie Bundle

EASY KNIT


This Scarf \& Beanie bundle comes in 3 size brackets. 3-6 yr olds, 7-teen, and adult size. The beanies are knitted flat and joined with a seam.

These are fairly quick projects all knitted in a k1/p1 rib, with creative and fun colour changing; perfect for beginner knitters to make matching items for you and your mini-me, or your bestie. The beanies come in two designs; a ONE-STRIPE or FIVE-STRIPE, and you can attach a pom-pom, or not. The scarfs come in 3 different designs with 2 different colour combinations each; a FIVE-STRIPE scarf; a TWO-STRIPE scarf, and a COLOUR-BLOCK scarf.

MEASUREMENTS \& YARN REQUIREMENTS: BEANIES

See size delineations; and below are codes that the pattern uses for colours.

Note: Multicolour PomPoms can be made with left over yarn from balls of contrast stripe colours.
For Solid Colour Pompoms, add 1 ball of colour of choice.

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm . For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5 cm . Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

3-6 years size beanie

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 15 mm knitting needles, 35 cm for SCARFS.
1 pair of 10 mm knitting needles, 30 cm for BEANIES.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.
Sullivans PomPom Maker.

## TENSION:

8 sts and 8 rows $\mathrm{k} 1 / \mathrm{pl}$ rib stitch using 15 mm needles.

## KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

c: colour
cc: colour combination
k: knit
k2tog: knit two stitches together
k2tog tbl: knit two stitches together through the back of the stitch loop.
p: purl
p2tog: purl two stitches together
p2tog tbl: purl two stitches together through the back of the stitch loop.
st(s) stitch(es)
tog together
[] repeat what's in the brackets

## NOTES:

You can follow the suggested pattern colours, or mix and match your own yarn colours.

## BEANIE PATTERN : FIVE-STRIPE BEANIE

Using Main Colour, and 10 mm straight needles, cast on 45 $(49,53)$ sts

Row 1: (right side), [K1,P1], to last stitch, K1.
Row 2: [P1, K1] to last stitch, P1.
For Sizes M \& L - Rows 3-4 Repeat Rows 1 and 2.
For Size S, go to row 5.
Work the next 5 rows in the chosen colour stripes order of 1 row per colour:
Row 5. Change colour. [K1,P1] rib to last stitch, K1.
Row 6. Change colour, $[\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{~K} 1]$ rib to last stitch, P 1 .
Row 7-9. Repeat rows 5 and 6.
Row 10. Change back to Main Colour; repeat rows 1 and 2 until knitting measures 15 ( $17,19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) ( $6,8,10$ rows) from the cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Crown Shaping
Next Row: [k2togtblk, p2tog] to last stitch, k1. $23(25,27)$ sts.
Next Row: [p1, k1] to last stitch, P1.
Next Row: [k1, p1] to last stitch, k1.
Next Row: [k2togtbl] to last stitch, K1 $(12,13,14)$ sts.

Next Row: Purl
Nex Row: (1st and 3rd sizes) [k2tog] to end
2nd size - [k2tog to last stitch], k1. $6(7,7)$ sts.

## ONE STRIPE BEANIE

Using Main Colour, 10 mm straight needles cast on $45(49,53)$ sts

Row 1. (right side), [K1,P1], to last stitch, K1.
Row 2. [P1, K1] to last stitch, P1.
For Sizes M \& L - Rows 3-4 Repeat Rows 1 and 2.
For Size S, go to row 5.
Work the next row in the chosen colour stripe:
Row 5. Change colour. [K1,P1] rib to last stitch, K1.
Row 6. Change back to Main Colour; repeat rows 1 and 2 until knitting measures 15 ( $17,19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) (14 rows) from the cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Crown Shaping
Next Row: [k2togtblk, p2tog] to last stitch, k1. $23(25,27)$ sts.
Next Row: [p1, k1] to last stitch, P1.
Next Row: [k1, p1] to last stitch, k1.
Next Row: [k2togtbl] to last stitch, K1 $(12,13,14)$ sts.
Next Row: Purl
Nex Row: (1st and 3rd sizes) [k2tog] to end
2nd size - [k2tog to last stitch], k1. $6(7,7)$ sts.

## FINISHING

Cut Yarn, leaving a long enough thread to sew up seam. Use a wool needle to thread yarn end through the live stitches remaining on your needle. Remove stitches from needle, draw up thread and secure. Sew the side seam.

## MAKING POMPOMS

1. Using 8 cm rings from Sullivans PomPom maker. If using cutout cardboard, make $2 \times 8 \mathrm{~cm}$ rings with 3 cm diameter hole in the centre.
2. Cut long lengths of each of a mix of 6 colours, or same colour yarn, twist and wind into a sausage shape ball, small enough to fit through the centre hole.
3. Wind the yarn through the centre and round the circles evenly and close together.
4. Continue until no more yarn will fit through the centre hole.
5. Use a sharp pair of scissors to snip through the yarn around the circumference of the circle.
6. Take a length of yarn and pass between the circles. Tie a tight knot to hold all the layers of the pompom together.

CC1 below refers to Colour Comination 1, and CC2 refers to Colour Combination 2.

## FIVE STRIPE SCARF

Note: This pattern uses 1 main colour with contrasting stripes in five different colours near the border ends of the scarf. It is a super luxurious size scarf in an adult size.

With Main Colour, cast on 26 sts
Row 1 to 12: K1/P1 Rib.
Row 13 to 17: Change Colours:
K1/P1 Rib Stripes (1 row each) in this colour order for
CC 1: C2, C6, C5, C4, C3.
CC 2: C5, C3, C2, C1, C4.
Row 18 to 98 Return to Main Colour and continue K1/P1 rib.
Row 99 to 103 Change to Stripe Colours, continuing in K1/P1 Rib,
in the opposite to the colour order, so:
CC 1: C3, C4, C5, C6, C2.
CC 2: C4, C1, C2, C3, C5.
Row 104 to 116 Change to Main Colour and continue K1/ P1 Rib for 12 rows.

Cast off in K1/P1 rib stitch.

## TWO STRIPE SCARF

Note: This pattern uses 2 colours in alternating stripes every two rows. Draw yarn colour up from previous knitted rows when changing colours, leaving a little bit of slack so to not pucker the edge, but enough tension so the thread hugs the edge also. The pattern is in 3-5yr, 7-teen and adult size.

With 15 mm needles cast on $8(12,16)$ sts with C 3 for CC 1 , and C1 for CC2.

Row 1 - 2: K1/P1 rib with yarn colour C3 for CC 1, and C1 for CC 2.

Row $3-4$ : K1/P1 rib with yarn colour C5 for CC 1, and C2 for CC 2 .

Repeat Rows 1 - 4 for $110(120,130)$ rows.
Cast off in K1/P1 rib stitch.

## COLOUR BLOCK SCARF

Note: This pattern uses 2 colours with contrast colour at the start and end of scarf, and comes in 7yr-teen size, and adult size.

With 15mm needles cast on 9 (13) sts with C3 for CC1 and C1 for CC2..

Row 1 to 22(18): K1/P1 rib with yarn colour with C3 for CC1 and C1 for CC2

Row 23(19) to 45(66):
K1/P1 rib with yarn colour C5 for CC 1, and C2 for CC 2.

Row 46(61) to 68(84):
K1/P1 rib with yarn colour with C3 for CC1 and C1 for CC2

Cast off in K1/P1 rib stitch.

FINISHING
With wool needle, sew all ends into stitch edges to neaten.
