Crystal Wrap

INTERMEDIATE CROCHET

This wrap is made in an uncomplicated stitch, in two tonal colours. The contrast colour is used to make the popcorn stitch stripe row, which highlights the texture of the Crystal yarn even more. The rounds increase incrementally, so you end up with 4 adjoining triangle shapes, that drape beautifully especially with the additional length of the tassels. This is a luxuriously cosy and warm garment, and the stitch work is open enough so it also breathes.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size

Circumference (at widest portion)	80 cm
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Length (with tassels)	98cm
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Yarn Required:

Makr CRYSTAL Yarn 250g balls

COLOURS:

Main: Natural/Brown	3 balls
Contrast: Platinume	1 ball
Tassels: Platinume	1 ball

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

A 10.00mm crochet hook
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

using 10mm hook 9tc & 4 rnds= 10cm x 10cm

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

[]	total number of sts on a row.
5 tr:	popcorn with 5 tr
ch:	chain
rep:	repeat
rnd:	round (row)
rs:	right side
sp(s):	space(s)
ss:	slip stitch
st(s):	stitch(es)
tr:	treble crochet
ws:	wrong side

Popcorn St Instruction:

5tr-popcorn: Work 5tr in same st/sp, remove hook from loop and insert from front to back in a first tr made, put loop back on hook and pull through first tr.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Main colour Natural Brown start with a magic ring.

1st rnd (RS).

Ch2 on top of ring ch (counts as first tr), 11 tr in ring, turn. [12 tr]

2nd rnd (WS).

Ch3 (counts as 1 tr here and throughout), 1 tr in each of next 2 tr, (ch2, 1 tr in each of next 3 tr) 3 times, turn. [12 tr, 3 ch-2 sps]

3rd rnd.

Ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, 1 tr in next tr, 2tr in next tr, (ch2, 2tr in next tr, 1 tr in next tr, 2 tr in next tr) 3 times, turn. [20 tr, 3 ch-2sps]

4th rnd.

Ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, 1 tr in each of next 3 tr, 2 tr in next tr, (ch2, 2tr in next tr, 1 tr in each of next 3 tr, 2 tr in next tr) 3 times, turn. [28 tr, 3 tr – 2 sps]

5th rnd.

Ch3 + 1 tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, 1 tr in each of next 5 tr, 2 tr in next tr, (ch2, 2tr in next tr, 1 tr in each of next 5 tr, 2tr in next tr) 3 times, turn [36 tr, 3 ch-2 sps]

6th rnd. Ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made (ch1, skip 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr) until there are 2 tr left before the ch-2 sp, ch1, skip 1 tr, 2tr in next tr, *ch2, 2tr in next tr, (ch1, skip 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr) until there are 2 tr left before the ch-2 sp or before row end, ch1, skip 1 tr, 2 tr in next tr; rep from *twice more, turn. [28 tr, 16 ch-1 sps, 3 ch-2 sps]

Change to Contrast colour Platinum

7th rnd. Ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, 1 tr in next tr, (5tr-popcorn in next ch1-sp, 1 tr in next tr) until there is 1 tr left before the ch-2 sp, 2tr in next tr, *ch2, 2tr in next tr, 1 tr in next tr, (5tr-popcorn in next ch1-sp, 1 tr in next tr) until there is 1 tr left before the tr2 sp or before row end, 2tr in next tr; rep from *twice more, turn [36 tr, 16 5tr-popcorns, 3 ch-2sps]

Change back to Main colour

8th rnd. ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, ch1, skip next tr, 1 tr in next tr, (ch1, skip popcorn, 1 tr in next tr) until there are 2 tr left before the ch-2 sp, ch1, skip next tr, 2tr in next tr, *ch2, 2tr in next tr, ch1, skip next tr, 1 tr in next tr, (ch1, skip popcorn, 1 tr in next tr) until there are 2 tr left before the ch2 sp or before row end, ch1, skip next tr, 2tr in next tr; rep from * twice more, turn [36tr, 24 ch-1 sps, 3ch-2 sps]

9th rnd. ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 just made, (1tr in next tr, 1 tr in next ch-1 sp) until there is 1 tr left before the ch-2 sp, 2tr in next tr, *ch2, 2tr in next tr, 1 tr in next tr, (1tr in next ch- sp, 1tr in next tr) until there is 1 tr left before the ch-2 sp or before row end, 2tr in next tr; rep from *twice more, turn. [68tr, 3 ch-2 sps]

10th rnd. Ch3 + 1tr in tr at base of ch3 jut made, 1 tr in each tr until there is 1 tr left before the tr-2 sp, 2tr in next tr, (ch2, 2tr in next tr, tr in each tr until there is 1 tr left before the ch-2 sp – or before row end on last rep, 2tr in next tr) 3 times, turn

11th - 13th rnd.
Rep Rnd 10

14th rnd: Rep Rnd 6

Rnd 15 – 29
Rep Rnd 7-14, then rep rnd 7-13.

Total 29 rows. [228 tr and 3ch-2sps]

TASSELS

Using Contrast Colour, cut 4 strands of 48cm length yarn. To tie strands onto the wrap; fold strands in half, and pull the centre (half-way point) of the fold through a space (inbetween a dc) at the cast off edge of the wrap; drawing the loop through about 4cm so it looks like a stitch loop. Take tails of yarn and draw through this stitch loop you've just created, pull tails gently to tighten.

Repeat, tying strands to every 2nd space at cast-off edge of the wrap.

FINISHING

Darn in crocheted ends with wool needle to neaten.
