



This unisex kids jumper comes in 3 sizes for; 1-2 yrs, 3-4 yrs, and 5-6 yrs. The model is wearing a 5-6 yrs size, and he is 5 years old. This is fairly easy and quick knitting with big needles. Made with 2 colours, you can choose any colour combination from the Velour Plush Jumbo yarn range.

The back has no shaping, and the front neckline shaping is straight- forward which is split into two portions, and either side of the neckline is worked separately. The sleeves also have some very basic shaping at the start, and are then knitted straight. To get a neat finish on your seams, follow the guides to seaming techniques at the end of the pattern.

YARN REQUIRED

Makr VELOUR PLUSH Jumbo 200gballs

Colour A	3	3	4
Colour B	2	2	3

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 20mm knitting needles 35cm length 1 x 15mm knitting needles 30cm length Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

5 sts x 7 rows stst on 20 mm needles = 10 cm x 10 cm

KNITITNG ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx: approximately C colour K knit

K2tog knit two stitches together

K2togtbl knit two stitches together through back of loop

P purl

P2tog purl 2 stitches together

P2togtbl purl 2 stitches together through back of loop Stst stocking stitch or stockinette stitch, (alternatively

k 1 row and p 1 row)

St(s) stitch(es)

() amount of sts or rows for the two larger sizes.* * repeat instructions inbetween asterixes.

JUMPER PATTERN

FRONT.

With Colour A cast on 18 (21, 24) sts.

Row 1-2: Work in k1/p1 rib.

For size 2: Work k1/p1 first row, and p1/k1 for second

row.

Row 3 - 11(15, 19): Work stst, beginning with p row (wrong

side).

PLACE SLEEVE MARKERS.

Change yarn to Colour B on k row.

Row 12(16,20) - 15(21,27):

Work 3 (5, 7) rows stst.

FRONT NECK SHAPING.

Row 16(22,28): K 7(8,9) sts

Join a second ball of yarn and cast off the

next 4(5,6) sts, k to end.

Now you will have both sides on one needle, both attached to separate balls of

yarn.

Working right side of neck (purl row facing you) Row 17(23,29): *P to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. 6(7,8) sts.

K row*.

Repeat * to * until 4 (5,6) sts remain.

Cast off on k row.

Working right side of neck (purl row facing you).

Row 17(23,29): *p1 p2tog tbl, p to end of row. 6(7,8) sts.

K row*.

Repeat * to * until 4 (5,6) sts remain.

Cast off on k row.

BACK:

Cast on 18 (21, 24) sts.

Row 1 - 2: Work in rib k1,p1 for 2 rows for sizes 1 and

3.

For size 2: Work k1/p1 first row, and p1/k1 for second

row.

Row 3 - 11(15,19) Beginning with a purl row, (wrong side),

work ss with Colour 1 until the back measures appox 20 (22, 25) cm. PLACE SLEEVE MARKERS.

Row 12(16,20) - Row 23(27,35).

Change to Colour 2 and work ss.

Cast off on k row.

SLEEVE:

Cast on 8 (10, 12) sts.

Row 1 - 2: Work in k1, p1 for 2 rows.

Row 3: *P row.

Row 4: Kinto b/f of st, k to last st, k into b/f of st. *

10 (12,14) sts.

Row 5 - 13: Repeat * * until 14 (16, 18) sts.

Row 14 - (20, 24,26):

Changing yarn to Colour B on P row, continue in stst until sleeve measures

approx 23 (25,28)cm.

Cast off.

TO FINISH:

NECKLINE & JOINING FRONT & BACK.

Join back and front on one shoulder using horizontal seam method.

With 15mm needle, and Colour 2, Pick up 12 (14, 16) sts from front neckline and 10(11,12) sts from back neckline. Work k1/p1 rib for 2 rows and cast off.

Join back and front on other shoulder using horizontal seam method, continuing up the collar using vertical seam method.

JOIING SLEEVES ONTO FRONT & BACK.

At sleeve markers, join sleeves to front and back using perpendicular seam method.

Joins sleeves together and front and back sides using vertical seam method.
