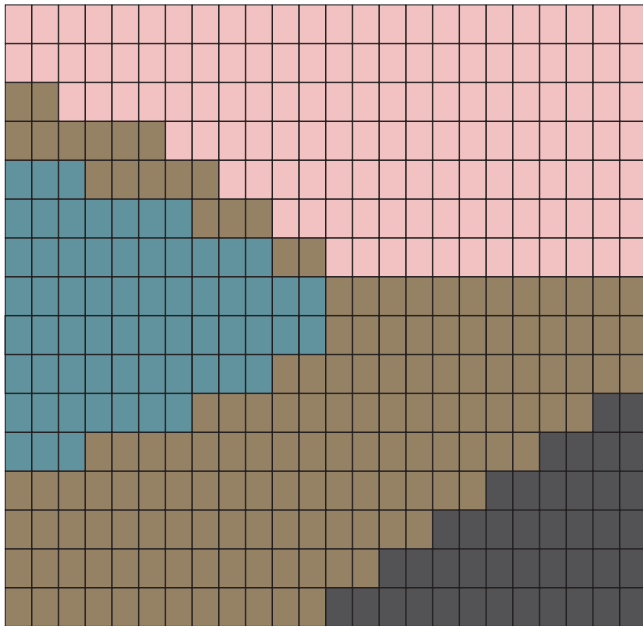

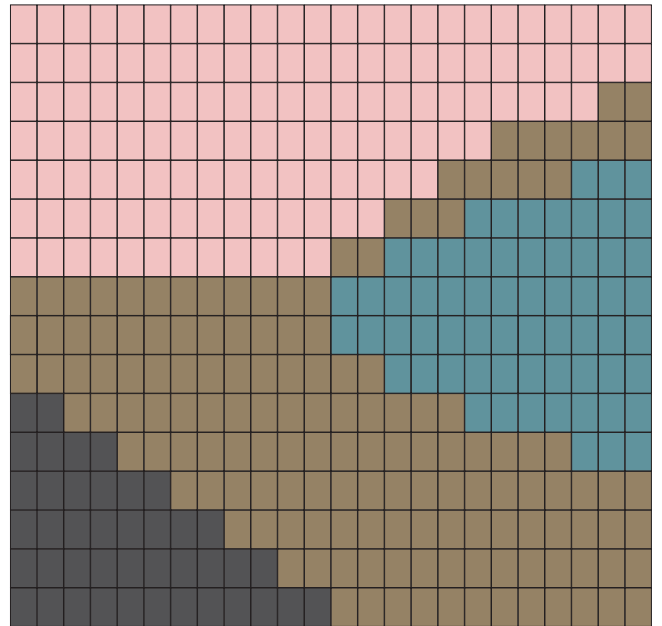

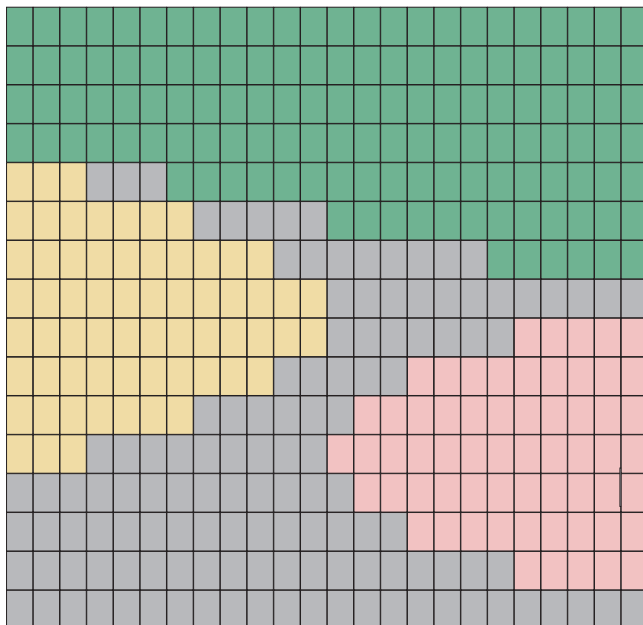

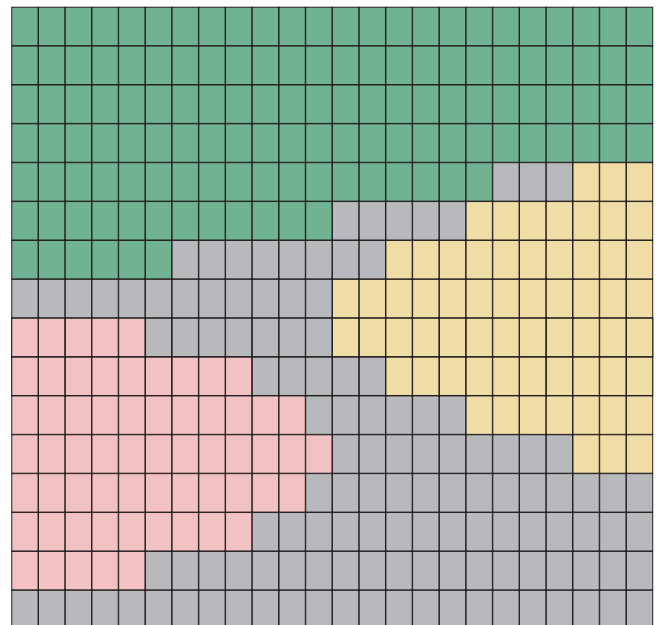

This is an easy and fun knitting project with some creative colour mixing. Made with an intarsia knitting technique, when changing colours twist the yarn strands around each other in the back of the knitting. There is a tendency for the yarn balls to also twist around each other during the knitting process; but this yarn is so chunky that it is very easy to untangle, and therefore really manageable to work with 2 or 3 balls of yarn at the same time. As per the diagram the front and back designs mirror each other so that the colour shapes meet at the seam edges.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE	47cm x 47cm
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YARN REQUIRED

Makr VELOUR PLUSH Jumbo 200g balls

Colour Combo 1

C1: Doeskin	2
C2: Volcanic Ash	1
C3: Allure	1
C4: Dusty Pink	1

Colour Combo 2

C1: High Rise	2
C2: Dusty Pink	1
C3: Lambswool	1
C4: Malachite Green	1

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 20mm knitting needles 35cm length
Wool needle for sewing in ends
Cushion Inserts 50cm x 50cm.

TENSION:

5 sts x 7 rows stst on 20mm needles = 10cm x 10cm

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

Stst	Stocking Stitch (alternatively k 1 row and p 1 row)

FINISHING

Sew Cast on edges together first, then the side seams.

Place cushion insert inside, and sew up the cast off edge.

Draw threads in to neaten.
