This stripe singlet is an easy knitting project, made on bigger needles so the garment will have a lovely airiness and drape. It is made with separate front and back pieces, and the straps are made with cast-off rows. The singlet comes in one size, and is a relaxed fit. The model is about a size 12.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE

Chest Width 45cm

Body Length (from shoulder strap) 60cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Col A – Black	1
Col B – Silver	1
Col C – Denim	1
Col D – White	1
Col E – Natural	1
Col F – Red	1
Col G – Bottle Green	1
Col H – Coral	1
Col I – Cream	1
Col J – Yellow	1
Col K – Navy	1
Col L – Hedge Green	1

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 8mm knitting needles
Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

14 st x 14 rows on stocking stitch = 10cm x 10cm

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

K	knit
K2tog	knit two stitches together
K2togtbl	knit two stitches together through back of loop
P	purl
P2tog	purl 2 stitches together
P2togtbl:	purl 2 stitches together through back of loop
Sl	Slip stitch
Stst	Stocking Stitch (alternatively k 1 row and p 1 row)
St(s)	stitch(es)

SINGLET

NOTES:

On a change of colour the last row should be on the wrong/purl side.

FRONT

With Colour A, cast on 58 stitches using the cable cast on method.

Row 1 - 8 Work in stocking stitch for 8 rows.

Row 9-10 Change to colour B and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 11-16 Change to colour C and work in stst for 6 rows.

Row 17-18 Change to colour D and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 19-20 Change to colour E and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 21-22 Change to colour F and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 23-24 Change to colour G and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 25-26 Change to colour H and work 2 rows in stst.

Row 27-30 Change to colour I and work 4 rows in stst.

Row 31-34 Change to colour J and work 4 rows in stst.
 Row 35-38 Change to colour K and work 4 rows in stst.
 Row 39-42 Change to colour L and work 4 rows in stst.
 Row 43-44 Change to colour A(black) and work 2 rows in stst.

SHAPING ARMHOLES

Row 45-46 Change to colour D(white) and work 2 rows in stst.
 Row 47 Cast off 3 stitches, k to the end of the row. (55 sts)
 Row 48 Cast off 3 sts, p to end of row. (52 sts)
 Row 49 Sl1 kw, k1, k2tog, k to the last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (50 sts)
 Row 50 Sl1 pw, p1, p2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2tog p1. (48 sts)
 Row 51 Sl1 kw, k1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 st. (46 sts)
 Row 52 Sl1 pw, p1, p2tog, p to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. (44 sts)

NECKLINE

Row 53 Sl1 kw, k1, k2tog, k16, cast off 4sts, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (38 sts)

You'll now have 19 stitches for the left side of the front – leave remaining sts on needle to work on later.

LEFT SIDE OF FRONT

Row 54 Working on 19 sts, sl1 pw, p to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1. (18 sts)
 Row 55 *Sl1 kw, k1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (16 sts)
 Row 56 Sl1 pw, p to end of the row.*
 Row 57-66 Repeat * to * a further 5 times until 6 sts remain.
 Row 67 Sl1 kw, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)
 Row 68. P2tog, p2tog. (2 sts)
 Row 68 K2tog (1 st)

STRAP

Cast on 13 sts using the cable cast on technique.

Cast off.

RIGHT SIDE OF FRONT

Rejoin yarn to other side.

Row 54 Sl1 pw, p1, p2tog, p to end of row. (18 sts)
 Row 55 *Sl1 kw, k1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (16 sts)
 Row 56 Sl1 pw, p to end of row.*
 Row 57-66 Repeat * to * a further 5 times until (6 sts) remain.
 Row 67 Sl1 st kw, k2tog, k2tog, k1. (4 sts)
 Row 68. P2tog, p2tog. (2 sts)
 Row 69. K2tog. (1 st)

STRAP

Cast on 13 sts using cable cast on method.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew the front and back together.

Neaten the joins between the straps and the body of the top.

Take the tail end of yarn where the straps meet the body and secure the strap to the main piece by making a few sts, approx. 0.5cm from the start of the strap. Repeat for each strap.
