EASY KNIT



This is an easy knitting project made in the knit stitch using an intarsia knitting technique to change colours. When changing colours the yarns are twisted around each other on the wrong side of the knitting. Using 3 colours, choose your own combination or follow our colours on the previous page as a guide.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE

Length 20cm

Width 20cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Col 1	1
Col 2	1
Col 3	1

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

1 pair of 4mm knitting needles
Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

21 st x 38 rows on garter stitch = 10cm x 10cm

KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

C	colour
K	knit
Ktog	knit stitches together
Sl	slip
St(s)	stitch(es)

WASH CLOTHS

With Colour 1, cast on 44 stitches using the cable cast on method.

Row 1 - 14:	With C1, knit. Cut thread to change to C2 and C3 to begin row 15.
Row 15:	C2 k1, C3 k43.
Row 16:	C3 k43, C2 k1.
Row 17:	C2 k2, C3 k42.
Row 18:	C3 k42, C2 k2.
Row 19:	C2 k3, C3 k41.
Row 20:	C3 k42, C2 k3.
Row 21:	C2 k4, C3 k40.
Row 22:	C3 k40, C2 k4.
Row 23:	C2 k5, C3 k39.
Row 24:	C3 k39, C2 k5.
Row 25:	C2 k6, C3 k38.

Cast off 30 sts with C2, cast off 11 sts with C3, k last 2 sts. (3 sts left on needle) Cut C2 off.

Row 77-97: k with C3.

Row 98: Pick up first st from row 76 (wrong side), ktog with first st on the row you're working on (row 98), pick up 2nd st from row 76 and ktog with 2nd st on the row you're working on, sl 1st st over 2nd st like a cast off action. Pick up 3rd st from row 76 and ktog with 3rd st on the row you're working on, sl 2nd st over 3rd st, and pull thread through.

FINISHING

Use a wool needle to sew in the yarn tails to neaten.
