EASY CROCHET



This bucket style crochet hat is an easy beginner project using basic single and double crochet stitch techniques working in the round. This is a fun and creative project using 3 colours, which you can either follow our colour suggestion, or choose your own from our awesome colour range of Makr Organic Cotton yarn. Model is also wearing knitted Tee from our Cotton T&Shorts free download pattern.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE

Width	32cm
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Length	16cm
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YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Col A – Silver	1
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Col B – Yellow	1
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Col C – Natural	1
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NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

5mm crochet hook

Stitch Marker

Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

17st x 20rows Dc = 10cm x 10cm

CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch: chain

Dc: Double crochet

Dc1: make 1 double crochet stitch

Dc2: make 2 single crochet stitches

Sl st: slip st

St: stitch

HAT

- Using Colour B create a magic loop and Dc 6 around it. Join the round by making a sl st into the first st of the round.

Working in the round.

- Make 1 ch st, then place marker. Dc 2 into each st. (12 sts)
- Place yarn marker to show the start of the round, do this at the beginning of each of the rounds. *Dc 2 into the next st, DC 1. * Repeat * to * a further 5 times (18 sts)
- *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 2.*. Repeat * to * a further 5 times. (24 sts)
- Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 3. Repeat * to * a further 5 times. (30 sts)
- Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 4. Repeat * to * a further 5 times. Join the round by making a sl st into the first st of the round and change to Colour C (36 sts)
- Change to colour C by working 1 ch st, then place marker. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 5.*. Repeat * to * a further 5 times (42 sts)

8. * Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 6. * Repeat * to * a further 5 times (48 sts)
9. * Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 7.* Repeat * to * a further 5 times (54 sts)
10. * Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 8 *. Repeat * to * a further 5 times (60 sts)
11. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 9*. Repeat * to * a further 5 times. (66 sts)
12. *Dc into the next st, Dc 10*. Repeat * to * a further 5 times. (72 sts)
13. *Dc into the next st, Dc 11.* Repeat * to * a further 5 times. (78 sts)
14. Work 6 rounds in Dc.
15. *Dc into the next st, Dc 38* Repeat * to * once more (80 sts)
16. Work 1 round in Dc.
17. Dc 19, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 39, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 20. (82 sts)
18. Work 1 round in Dc. Join the round by making a sl st into the first st of the round, then change to colour A.
19. With Colour A work 1 ch st, then place marker. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 40. *. Repeat * to * once more. (84 sts).
20. Dc 20, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 41, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 21. (86 sts).
21. Work 1 round in Dc.
22. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 42.* Repeat the section inside the asterixes once more. (88 sts)
23. Dc 21, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 43, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 22. (90 sts)
24. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 44* Repeat * to * once more. (92 sts)
25. Dc 22, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 45, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 23. Join the round by making a sl st into the first st of the round and then change to colour B.
26. Change to colour B by working 1 ch st, then place marker. Work 1 round in Dc.
27. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 46.*. Repeat * to * once more. (96 sts)
28. Dc 23, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 47, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 24. (98 sts)
29. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 48*. Repeat * to * once more. Join the round by making a sl s into the first st of the round then change to colour A. (100 sts)
30. Change to colour A by working 1 ch st, then place marker. Dc 24, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 49, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 25. (102 sts)
31. Work 1 round in Dc.
32. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 50* Repeat * to * once more (104 sts)
33. Dc 25, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 51, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 26. (106 sts)
34. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 52.* Repeat * to * once more. (108 sts)
35. Dc 26, Dc 2 into the next st, Sc53, Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 27. (110 sts)
36. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 10 *. Repeat * to * a further 9 times. (120 sts)
37. Work 1 round in Dc.
38. *Dc 2 into the next st, Dc 19* Repeat a further 5 times. (126 sts)
39. Work 1 round in Dc.
40. Secure last st by pulling cut yarn through loop.
