

Baby Blanket

INTERMEDIATE KNIT

This baby blanket is a lovely heirloom project knitted in a repeating textured knot stitch pattern, with a non-rolling edged border. It is knitted flat in a square shape and is a fairly simple project which can be tackled by beginner knitters also.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE	
Width	92cm
Length	92cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Cream	6	

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY •••

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

5mm, 80cm length circular needles 6mm, 80cm length circular needles for casting off Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

5mm: 16sts x 20 rows per 10cm in knot stitch pattern

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

K knit P purl

Garter Knit all rows

Knot Purl the next 3 stitches together, do not drop

them from the needle. Knit the same 3 stitches together, then purl the same 3 stitches together.

Drop the stitches from the left needle.

BLANKET PATTERN

This pattern is knitted flat.

Cast on a multiple on 147 sts. (137 for the knot st repeat section, plus 10 extra sts for the garter st border, which is 5 sts either side of the knot stitch pattern).

Knit first 6 rows in garter st for bottom border.

Knot St Repeat:

Row 1: knit Row 2: purl

Row 3: k1 *make knot, k3* repeat from * to last 4 sts,

make knot, k1.

Row 4. purl Row 5. knit Row 6. purl

Row 7. k4 *make knot, k3* repeat from *to last st, k1

Row 8. purl

Work until length measures approximately 90cm from the cast on edge within the 8 row repeat.

Finish off with 6 rows in garter st for top border. Cast off with 6mm needle so the cast off edge doesn't pucker, and so there is a nice square form for the blanket.

TO FINISH

Darn in all ends to neaten. Block with a steam iron.
