


COLOURING-IN PATTERN TEMPLATE



MAKR ORGANIC COTTON YARN COLOURS



Pencil Sleeves

EASY KNIT

This is like a double colouring-in project for both adults and kids alike. First use your colour pencils to experiment with colour combinations for the knitting pattern using our colouring-in template. Then knit the pattern colours to make pencil sleeves. The addition of these covers to the colour pencils will bring a whole new excitement to your next colouring-in project. This is a simple tube knitting technique using either circular or double pointed needles, where only the knit stitch is worked to the end of a row and the knitting is not turned, but instead the stitches are slid to the other end of the needle so the next row can be worked from the right side again.

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Various Colours	1		
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NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

Either: 3.5mm double pointed needles or 3.5 mm circular needles (30-40cm length) Wool needle for sewing in ends Colour Pencils

TENSION:

3.5mm: $24sts \times 20 \text{ rows} = 10cm \times 10cm.$

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

cm centimeters k knit rs right side st(s) stitche(es) ws wrong side

PENCIL SLEEVE PATTERN

PATTERN 1.

2 COLOUR BLOCK – 12 rows each colour.

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat **so you have 12 rows total.
- 4. Change to Colour 1.
- 5. Repeat * * for 12 rows.

24 rows total.

Cast off.

PATTERN 2.

2 COLOUR STRIPE- 2 rows each colour.

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row.
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row *
- 3. Repeat **so you have 2 rows total.
- 4. Change to Colour 2.
- 5. Repeat **for 2 rows.
- 6. Repeat rows 2 to 4, alternating colours every 2 rows, until you have 24 rows total.

Cast off.

PATTERN 3.

4 COLOUR COMBINATION

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat ** for 10 rows.
- 4. Change to Colour 2. Work 2 rows from * to *.
- 5. Change to Colour 3. Work 6 rows
- 6. Change to Colour 4. Work 6 rows.

Total 24 rows.

Cast off.

PATTERN 4.

3 COLOUR COMBINATION

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat ** for 8 rows.
- 4. Change to Colour 2.
- 5. Repeat * to * for 4 rows.
- 6. Change colours every 4 rows, until 4 stripes in total (additional 16 rows in total).

PATTERN 5.

3 COLOUR BLOCK

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat ** for 8 rows.
- 4. Change to colour 2 and repeat * to * for 8 rows.
- 5. Change to colour 3 and repeat * to * for 8 rows.

Total 24 rows.

Cast off.

PATTERN 6.

1 COLOUR

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat ** for 24 rows.

Cast off.

PATTERN 7.

2 COLOURS / STRIP OF CONTRAST COLOUR AT TOP

Cast on 5 sts with Colour 1.

- 1. K row
- 2. *Slide sts to other end of needle, and k starting on the RS of the row.*
- 3. Repeat * to * for 22 rows in total.
- 4. Change to Colour 2, and repeat * to * for 2 rows.

24 rows total.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends into WS with wool needle to neaten. Fit Sleeve over Pencil.
