EASY KNIT

This unisex kid's beanie is knitted flat with a seam, and shaping on the crown. It can be knitted in our Organic Cotton, Baby 8ply Merino, and our Baby Soft 8ply. Just observe the gauge and needle measurements between the cotton and wool yarns.

MEASUREMENTS

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

Lincraft BABY 8PLY MERINO Yarn 50g balls

Makr BABY SOFT 8PLY Yarn 100g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY •••

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

for ORGANIC COTTON: 3.75mm straight knitting needles 4mm straight knitting needles

for BABY 8PLY MERINO and BABY SOFT 8PLY: 4mm straight knitting needles 5mm, straight knitting needles

Wool needle for sewing in ends

TENSION:

ORGANIC COTTON: 3.75mm: 24sts x 30 rows = 10cm x 10cm stst.

BABY 8PLY MERINO and BABY SOFT 8PLY: 4mm: 22sts x 30 rows = 10cm x 10cm.

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

K	knit
K2tog	knit 2 stitches together
P	purl
Psso	pass slip stitch over
SI	slip stitch
St(s)	stitch(es)

BEANIE PATTERN

This pattern is knitted flat.

3.75(4.00)mm needles, cast on 91(93,95) sts Work 7 rows stocking st 8th row (foldline): Knit Change to 4.00(5.00)mm needles. Work in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until work measures 13(14-16) cm from beg, ending with a knit row. Next row: P29 (17-11) sts, *P2tog, P29 (17-12), rep from * to end ... 89 sts.

Shape Crown

Shape Crown:		
1st row:	k8, [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso,k15] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k8, 81 sts.	
2nd and alt rows: Purl		
3rd row:	k7 [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso, k13] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k7 73 sts.	
5th row:	k6, [k2tog, k3, al1, k1, psso, k11] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k1 65 sts.	
7th row:	k5, [k2tog, k3, al1, k1, psso, k9] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k5 57sts.	
9th row:	k4, [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso, k7] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k4 49 sts.	
11th row:	k3, [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso, k5] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k3 41 sts.	
13th row:	k2, [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso, k3] 3 times, k2tog, k3,	
	sl1, k1, psso, k2 33 sts.	
15th row:	k1, [k2tog, k3, sl1, k1, psso] 4 times 25 sts	
17th row:	k1, [k2tog, k2, sl1, k1, psso] 4 times 17 sts.	
18th row:	p1, [p2tog] 8 times 9 sts.	

TO FINISH

Darn in all ends to neaten. Block with a steam iron.
