# Cable Cardigan

EASY KNIT

This cardigan is made with one rectangular panel for the back and two rectangular panels for the front. You will knit cables along the two front panels, working from the bottom up. Sleeves are knit flat. Block panels and sleeves to shape and size before final assembly. The circular needles are used to hold a lot of stitches comfortably for the back panel, rather than used to knit circular, as the pieces are knitted flat.

#### **YARN REQUIRED**

#### Makr HYGGE TWIST Yarn 140g balls



NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

#### **DIFFICULTY** •••

## **NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:**

9mm knitting needles circular and straight needles Cable Needle Scissors Wool needle for darning in ends Measuring Tape

#### **TENSION:**

9mm: 9sts x 12rows = 10cm x 10cm stst.

## **KNITTING ABBREVIATION:**

- K: knit
- P: Purl
- St(s): stitch(es)
- Stst: Stocking Stitch (alternately knit 1 row, purl 1 row)

# **CABLE PATTERN**

A 10 stitch cable is worked within the pattern as follows:

5/5 LC: 10 stitch left cable. Slip 5 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k5, k5 from cable needle.

5/5 RC: 10 st right cable. Slip 5 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k5, k5 from cable needle.

#### CARDIGAN PATTERN BACK

#### DACK

Cast on 58 (64, 70, 76)

Row 1 – 7: K1/P1 rib pattern repeat across the row.

Row 8: Work stst until panel measures 75cm (80cm, 85cm, 90cm)

Cast off and weave in all ends.

# **FRONT PANEL**

(make 2)

Cast on 31 (35, 37, 41) sts.

Row 1 – 7: K1/P1 rib pattern repeat across the row; starting row with knit stitch where there is a purl stitch on the previous row, and purl stitch where there is a knit stitch on previous row.

## **CABLE PATTERN**

Row 8: k

Row 9. K8 (10,11,13), p15, k8(10,11,13)

Row 10-15:Repeat row 8 & 9

Row 16: K8 (10,11,13), 5/5 LC, k13(15,16,18).

Row 17: Repeat Row 9.

Row 18 - 25: Repeat rows 8 & 9

Row 26: K13(15,16,18), 5/5 RC, k 8(10,11,13)

Row 27: Repeat Row 9.

Repeat rows 8 – 27 until piece measures approximately 75cm(80cm, 85cm, 90cm and is the same length as the back panel.

Cast off and weave in ends.

#### **SLEEVES**

(make 2)

\*each decrease row reduces stitch count by 2

Cast on 38 (42,44,48) sts using cable cast on method.

Rows 1-7: Work stst.

Row 8: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (decrease row)

Repeat rows 1-8 until sleeve width sleeve length measures approx 38cm (39cm, 39cm, 40cm).

Next, work k1/p1 rib pattern for cuff for approximately 4cm for all sizes. Total sleeve length should measure approx. 42cm (43cm, 43cm, 45cm)

Cast off and weave in all ends.

# **TO FINISH**

Join front and back shoulders using horizontal seaming method. Join up to garter (knit) stitch edge.

Join sleeves to front/back apex using perpendicular seaming method.

Seam sleeves together using vertical seaming method.

Seam up sides of cardigan using vertical seaming method.

Weave in all ends to tidy.
