

Mumsy Slippers

EASY KNIT

For keeping toes snug on chilly nights (or days), this easy slipper pattern is knitted similar to socks on double pointed needles, and makes a great gift for loved ones.

MEASUREMENTS

	XS/S	M/L
Foot Length	25 cm	27cm
Foot Width	22cm	25cm

YARN REQUIRED

1 Ball of Makr SOFT & LUXE Yarn 100g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

5mm set of double pointed needles Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

5mm: 20 st and 28 rows = 10cm in St St blocked

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

Dec('d) decrease(d) K knit

K2Tog knit 2 sts together

P purl
RS right side
SI slip purlwise

SSK slip, slip, knit (slip 1 knitwise, slip 1 knitwise,

insert left needle into front of 2 slipped sts from

left; from this position, K2Tog)

St(s) stitch(es)

St St stockinette stitch (K on RS, P on WS)

WS wrong side WYIB with yarn in back WYIF with yarn in front

SLIPPERS PATTERN

Using cable cast-on method, cast on 6 sts.

HEEL FLAP

Starting with knit row, work 16 (18) rows in St St. With RS facing, bind off to end (1 st remains on right needle). Do not cut yarn or fasten off.

HEEL

Row 1 (RS): Pivot work a quarter turn clockwise, pick up and knit 12 (13) sts evenly spaced along edge; pivot work a quarter turn clockwise, with Needle 2, pick up and knit 4 sts along cast-on edge; pivot work a quarter turn clockwise, with Needle 3, pick up and knit 13 (14) sts evenly spaced along edge. [30 (32) sts]

Work as follows for 31/2"/9cm, beginning with WS row and ending with RS row:

Row 1 (WS): WYIF SI 2 sts, purl to end. Row 2 (RS): WYIB SI 2 sts, knit to end.

FOOT

WS facing, continuing with Needle 3, cable cast-on 11 (13) sts firmly; turn work. To join in round, WYIB slip first st on Needle 1 to Needle 3; pass last cast-on st over. [40 (44) sts] Redistribute sts evenly on 4 needles with center of cast-on sts as new beginning of round. Knit in round until piece measures 4.5 (5)cm shorter than desired finished length.

SHAPE TOE

Round 1 (dec): Needle 1: K to last 3 sts, K2Tog, K1; Needle 2: K1, SSK, K to end; Needles 3 & 4: Repeat as for Needles 1 & 2. Round 2: Knit. Repeat Rounds 1 & 2 until 24 sts remain, ending with Round 2. Repeat Round 1 until 8 sts remain.

FINISHING

Break yarn, leaving 20cm tail. With darning needle, thread tail through, draw up tightly.
