Woven Look Cushions

MAKR
COTTAGE LOOM

EASY KNIT

These are easy stitch patterns that have a woven look so the knitting looks like fabric, which creates a lovely and also robust effect for cushions. Knitted in our Cottage Loom Yarn which has gradient light to dark colours, brings extra depth and contrast to the patterning effect in the knitting.

MEASUREMENTS

	Square	Rectangle
Length	35cm	50cm
Width	35cm	30cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr COTTAGE LOOM Yarn 100g balls

Colour 1: C1 Smokey(Grey)	1	1
Colour 2: C2 Pearlescent(Beige)	1	1
Colour 3: C3 Dusk Orange	1	1
Colour 4: C4 Coastal (Blue)	1	1

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

6mm straight knitting needles
Wool or felt needle for sewing in ends.
Cushion Insert: Square 35cm x 35cm
Cushion Insert: Rectangle 30cm x 50cm

TENSION:

6mm: 14 st x 20 rows over stst = 10cm x 10cm

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

C	Colour
K	knit
P	purl
Sl	slip stitch
Sl kw	slip stitch knit-wise
Sl pw	slip stich purl-wise
Wl.bk	take wool to the back of the knitting
Wl.fwd	bring wool to the front of the knitting

TO FINISH

Sew bottom and sides.
Sew bottom side using invisible horizontal seaming method, and sides using square chain stitch method.
Insert cushion and sew top seams together using invisible horizontal seaming method.

SQUARE CUSHION PATTERN

KNIT BACK AND FRONT THE SAME

With C1 cast on 60 sts,
Row 1 – 8 *K1/p1 repeat* to end.

Change to C2

Row 1. *(K1, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k1), repeat *to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2) repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 5. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Change to C3

Row 1. *(P1, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p1) repeat * to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 5: *(Wl.bk, sl 3 pw, wl.fwd, p2), repeat * to end.

Change to C4 (blue)

Row 1 – 8. K.

Change to C3 (orange)

Row 1. K.

Row 2. P.

Change to C2 (beige)

Row 1. K1/P1 repeat.

Row 2. P1/K1 repeat.

Row 3 – 7 Repeat rows 1&2.

Change to C3 and C4

Row 1. *C3 p6, C4 p6* repeat * to * carrying threads across the purl side (ws) and twisting the yarn colours over each other to change.

Row 2. *C4 k6, C3 k6* repeat * to*.

Row 3 & 4: Repeat rows 1&2.

Row 5. *C4 p6, C3 , p6* repeat * to*.

Row 6. *C3, p6, C4, p6* repeat * to *

Rows 7&8: Repeat rows 5&6

Row 9. *C3 k3, C4 k3* repeat * to *

Row 10-16. *C4 k3, C3 k3* repeat * to *

Change to C2 (beige)

Row 1. K1/P1 repeat.

Row 2. P1/K1 repeat.

Row 3 – 7. Repeat rows 1&2.

Change to C3

Row 1. K.

Row 2. P.

Change to C4

Row 1 – 8. K.

Change to C3:

Row 1. *(K1, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k1), repeat *to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2) repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 5. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Change to C2

Row 1. *(P1, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p1) repeat * to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 5: *(Wl.bk, sl 3 pw, wl.fwd, p2), repeat * to end.

Change to C1;

Row 1 – 8. *K1/p1 repeat* to end.

Cast off.

RECTANGLE CUSHION PATTERN

KNIT BACK AND FRONT THE SAME

With C2 cast on 50 sts,

Row 1 – 30. *K1/p1 repeat* to end.

Change to C1

Row 1. *(K1, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k1), repeat *to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2) repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 5. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Change to C3

Row 1. *(P1, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p1) repeat * to end.

Row 2. *(Wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2). Repeat * to end.

Row 3. *(Wl.bk, sl1 pw, p2, wl.bk, sl3 pw, wl.fwd, p2, wl.bk, sl2 pw) repeat * to end.

Row 4. *(Wl.fwd, sl1pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl3 pw, wl.bk, k2, wl.fwd, sl2 pw*). Repeat * to end.

Row 5: *(Wl.bk, sl 3 pw, wl.fwd, p2), repeat * to end.

Change to C4 (blue)

Row 1 – 8. K.

Change to C3 (orange)

Row 1. K.

Row 2. P.

Change to C1 (grey)

Row 1. K1/P1 repeat.

Row 2. P1/K1 repeat.

Row 3 – 7. Repeat rows 1&2.

Change to C2 (beige)

Row 1. P.

Row 2. K.

Change to C3 and C4

Row 1. *C3 p6, C4 p6* repeat * to * to last 2 sts, C4 k2, carrying threads across the purl side (ws) and twisting the yarn colours over each other to change.

Row 2. C4 k2, *C4 k6, C3 k6* repeat * to*.

Row 3 & 4: Repeat rows 1&2.

Row 5. *C4 p6, C3 p6* repeat * to * to last 2 sts, C3 k2.

Row 6. *C3, p6, C4, p6* repeat * to *

Rows 7&8. Repeat rows 5&6

Row 9. *C3 k3, C4 k3* repeat * to * to last 2 sts, C3 k2.

Row 10-16. C4 k2, ,C4 k3, C3 k3* repeat * to *

Change to C4 (Blue)

Row 1. K1/P1 repeat.

Row 2. P1/K1 repeat.

Row 3–20. Repeat rows 1&2.

Cast off.
