

Wisteria Sleeve Top

INTERMEDIATE KNIT

This lovely lace sleeve top is made with straight needles, starting with the sleeve panels which are knitted separately. The back and front are also knitted flat from the bottom up with straight needles, which are then sewn onto the sleeve panels. To finish, the neckline stitches and sleeve cuffs are picked up with a circular needle and knitted in a rib stitch in the round.

YARN REQUIRED

Makr ORGANIC COTTON Yarn 100g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY •••

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

3.25mm straight knitting needles for the body 4mm straight knitting needles for the sleeves 3.25mm circular knitting needles for the neckline and cuffs Wool needle for darning in ends Removable Stitch Markers x 5

TENSION:

4mm: $22sts \times 28rows = 10cm \times 10cm stst.$

WISTERIA SLEEVE TOP PATTERN:

RIB STITCH PATTERN

K1, P1 Rib (odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end.

Row2 (WS): *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

LACE PATTERN

Note: After working rows 1-4, you will have a repeat of 17 sts, and after working rows 5-10, you will have a repeat of 15 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, yo, k5, yo, S2KP2, yo, k5, yo, k1 – 2 sts inc'd, 17 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Purl to end.

Row 3: K1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, p1, yo, k1,

k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1.

Row 4: P4, k1, p3, k1, p3, k1, p4.

Row 5: K1, yo, k1, k2tog, p1, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog,

p1, ssk, k1, yo, k1 – 2 sts dec'd, 15 sts.

Row 6: P4, k1, [p2, k1] 2 times, p4.

Row 7: [K1, yo] 2 times, k2tog, p1, ssk, p1, k2tog,

p1, ssk, [yo, k1] 2 times.

Row 8: P5, k1, [p1, k1] 2 times, p5.

Row 9: K1, yo, k3, yo, sssk, p1, k3tog, yo, k3, yo, k1.

Row 10: Purl to end. Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

SLEEVE PANELS

(make two)

With 4mm straight needles, cast on 33 sts.

Set-up Row (WS): P1, pm, p15, pm, k1, pm, p15, pm, p1.

Row 1 (RS): K1, sl m, work Row 1 of Lace patt to m, sl m,

p1, sl m, work Row 1 of Lace patt to m, sl m,

k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, sl m, work Row 2 of Lace patt to m, sl m,

k1, sl m, work Row 2 of Lace patt to m, sl m,

p1.

Rows 1-2 establish patt. Cont as est'd until Sleeve Panel meas 43, 43, 48cm from cast-on edge, ending with a WS Row. Cast off all sts.

FRONT & BACK the same.

With 3.25mm straight needles cast on 103, 113, 125 sts.

Rib Hem as per Stitch Pattern Instructions on Page 2. Work Rib for 30cm

Work stst for 24,26,27cm.

Transfer to circular needle to accommodate large number of stitches.

Sleeve shaping:

Continue working stocking stitch with the following cast on additions at the beginning of the rows.

Cast on 6 sts at the start of the next four rows. (127, 149,161)

Work 17 rows of stst.

Cast on 7 sts at the start of the next four rows. (155,177,189)

Work 12 rows of stst.

Cast on 8 sts at the start of the next four rows. (187, 209,221)

Work 8 rows of stst.

Cast on 4sts at the start of the next four rows. (203,225, 237)

Cast on 5sts at the start of the next four rows. (223,245,257) sts

Cast off 93, 98, 106 and place marker which indicates where sleeve join ends and neckline edge begins. Cast off 49,49,51 and place marker which indicates where neckline ends and where second sleeve join begins. Cast off the rest of 93, 98, 106 sts.

FINISHING

Sew Lace Sleeve Panels to Front and Back to end where markers are. Sew Side seams of the body.

NECK EDGING

With 3.25mm circular needle and RS facing, beg at Right shoulder;

- -Pick up and knit 31 sts evenly along Sleeve Panel, 1 Corner st along Back Neck cast-on edge (place removable m on this st).
- 47, 47,49, sts along Back Neck cast-on edge, 1 Corner st along Back Neck cast-on edge, (place removable m on this st),
- 31 sts along Sleeve Panel, 1 Corner st along Front Neck cast-on edge (place removable m on this st),
- 47, 47, 49, sts along Back Neck cast-on edge, 1 Corner st along Front Neck cast-on edge (place removable m on this st) –

160, 160, 164, sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Rnd 1: [Work in K1, P1 Rib to 1 st bef Corner st, S2KP2] 3 times, work in K1, P1 Rib to 1 st bef Corner st, S2KP2 (removing bor m as needed to complete dec), replace bor m – 8 sts dec'd, (152, 152, 156,) sts rem.

Rnd 2: Work even as est'd to end.

Rnd 3: [Cont as est'd to 1 st bef Corner st, S2KP2] 3 times, cont as est'd to 1 st bef Corner st, S2KP2 (removing bor m as needed to complete dec), replace bor m – 8 sts dec'd, (144, 144, 148,) sts rem.

Rnds 4-5: Rep Rnds 2-3 – 8 sts dec'd, (136, 136, 140,) sts rem.

Rnd 6: Work even as est'd to end. Cast off all sts in patt.

SLEEVE CUFFS

With 3.25mm circular needle and RS facing, beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit (44, 46, 46) sts evenly along Sleeve Cuff.

PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Work in K1, P1 Rib until piece meas 4cm from picked-up edge.

Bind off all sts in patt.

Weave in rem ends.
