Teddy Soft Jacket

EASY KNIT

This super cozy boxy jacket has a curved neckline and front opening; the body portions are wide and crop length, with a drop-shoulder set-in sleeve. The armhole join is shaped like a tailored cut, so the stitches decrease, and then increase, so there is a slight curve in the sleeve apex, which creates more movement in the sleeves. The garment is made in the knit stitch, so the right side and the wrong side of the fabric look the same. This is why the left and right fronts are made identical, as one side can be turned over to mirror the other; and the necklines meet in the middle. This is fairly easy knitting with basic shaping techniques, so this is an accessible project for beginners and a breeze for the more advanced knitter.

### YARN REQUIRED

#### Makr TEDDY SOFT 100g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

### DIFFICULTY ●●●

#### NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

15mm Knitting Needles  
Tapestry Needle  
Stitch Markers

#### TENSION:

6 sts x 7 rows = 10cm x 10cm.

#### KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS:

### JACKET

#### FRONTS

Make 2 the same.

Row 1. Cast on 28(30,32,34) sts.

Row 2. K.

Row 3. kfb of st\*, repeat twice \*, k to end of row. (31(33,35,37) sts).

Row 4. K to last 2 sts, kfb of st\*, repeat \*. (33(35,37,39) sts)

Row 5. Kfb of st, k to end of row. (34(36,38,40) sts)

Row 6. K row.

Row 7. Kfb of st, k to end of row. (35(37,39,41) sts)

Row 8. K row.

Row 9. Kfb of st, k to end of row. (36(38,40,42) sts)

Row 10-33(35,37,39): K row.

Place marker for sleeve join, approx 24(25,26,27)cm.

Row 34 (36,38,40). K2tog, k to end of row.  
35(37,39,41) sts

Row 35 (37,39,41 – 40(42,44,46). K.

Row 41 (43,45,47). K to last 2 sts, k2tog.  
34(36,38,40) sts

Row 42 (44,46,48) -47(49,51,53). K.

### SHAPING NECKLINE

Row 48(50,52,54). Cast off 3 sts, k to last 2 sts, kfb  
of st. (32(34,36,38) sts)

Row 49(51,53,55). K to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2tog.  
(30(32,34,36) sts)

Row 50(52,54,56). K2tog, k to end of row.  
(29(31,33,35) sts)

Row 51(53,55,57). K to last 2 sts, k2tog.  
(28(30,32,34) sts)

Row 52(54,56,58). K.

Row 53(55,57,59). K to last 2 sts, k2tog.  
(27(29,31,33) sts)

Row 54(56,58,60). K.

Row 55(57,59,61). K to last st, kfb st.  
(28(30,32,34) sts)

Row 56(58,60,62). K.

Row 57(59,61,63). K2tog, k to end of row.  
(27(29,31,33) sts)

Row 58(60,62,64). K.

For Size Size S c/o 27 sts.

Size Size M:

Row 59. K.

Row 60. K2tog, k to end of row  
(28, 30, 32)sts

Row 61. K.

c/o 28 sts.

For Size L:  
Row 63. K.

Row 64. K2tog, k to end of row 29(31)

Row 65. K.

c/o 29 sts.

For Size XL:

Row 66. K.

Row 67. K2tog, k to end of row 30 sts.

Row 68. K.

c/o 30 sts.

Total rows: 58 (61, 65, 68)

### BACK

Row 1. Cast on 66 (69,72,75) sts.

Row 2-33(35,37,39). K.

Place markers for sleeve joins approx 24(25,26,27)cm.

Row 34(36,38,40). K2tog, K to last 2 sts, k2tog.  
(68(71,73,77) sts)

Row 35(37,39,41) – 39(41,43,45). K.

Row 40(42,44,46). K2tog, K to last 2 sts, k2tog.  
(70(73,75,79) sts)

Row 41(43,45,47) – 45(47,49,51). K.

Row 46(48,50,52). K into b/f of st, K to last st, kfb of  
st (68(71,73,77) sts)

Row 47(49,51,53) – 51(53,55,57). K.

Row 52(54,56,58). K into b/f of st, K to last st, kfb  
of st (66 (69,72,75) sts)

Row 53(55,57,59)- 54(56,58,60). K.

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EASY KNIT

Row 55 (57,59,61). K29(30,31,32) sts, cast off 8(9,10,11) sts, k29(30,31,32).

## First side of back neck-line shaping:

Row 56 (58,60,62). k 29(30,31,32) sts, turn knitting (leave other 29(30,31,32) sts on needle of other side of neckline to work on later)

Row 57. k2tog, k to end (28(29,30,31) sts)

Row 58. k to last 2 sts, k2tog (27(28,29,30)sts)

Row 59. K.

Size S: C/o

Size M : Row 60-63: C/o K.

Size L : Row 63-64 C/o K.

Size XL : Row 65-66 C/o K.

Total rows: 59 (61, 65, 68)

## Other Side of back neck-line shaping:

Join thread to other 29(30,31,32) sts,

Row 56. K.

Row 57-59 (61, 65, 68). Work the same as rows of other side of neckline.

## SLEEVES

Make 2 the same

Cast on 26(28,30,32) sts.

Row 1-7. K.

Row 8. Kfb of st, k to last st, kfb of st (28, 30,32,34sts)

Row 9-15. K.

Row 16. Kfb of st, k to last st, kfb of st (30,32,34,36sts)

Row 17-23. K.

Row 18. Kfb of st, k to last st, kfb of st (32,34,36,38 sts)

Row 19-28. K.

Row 29. Cast off 4(5,6,7)sts, k to end (28,30,32,34 sts)

Row 30. Cast off 4(5,6,7)sts, k to end (24,26,28,30sts)

Row 31. Cast off 4(5,6,7)sts, k to end. (20,22,24,26sts)

Row 32. Cast off 4(5,6,7) sts, k to end. (16,18,20,22sts)

Row 33. Cast off 16(18,20,22) sts.

## TO FINISH

Join fronts to back at shoulders.

Join sleeves to fronts/back at sleeve markers.

Close up sleeves and front and back side joins.

Sew in loose threads to neaten.
