Diagonal Knit Blanket

EASY KNIT

Make this cosy asymmetric blanket, which is knitted diagonally by increasing into the corners then decreasing from the centre. Starting with straight needles, then switching to circular needles to knit back and forth when the blanket gets too wide; this is a perfect beginners project, which will grow quickly with our soft to the touch FUZZY yarn.

MEASUREMENTS

YARN REQUIRED

Makr FUZZY YARN Yarn 200g balls

C3 Nutshell	6

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

15mm straight knitting needles 15mm circular knitting needles Wool needle for darning in ends

TENSION:

15mm: $6sts \times 8rows = 10cm \times 10cm stst$

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

Alt alternative
Approx approximately
Beg beginning
Cont continue
Inc Increase (kfb)

K knit

St(s)

K2tog knit two stitches together to decrease

Kfb Knit into the front and the back of the stitch to

increase stitch(es)

Stst stocking stitch (alternatively knit 1 row, purl 1

row)

BLANKET PATTERN

BUILDING THE FIRST CORNER:

Cast on 2 sts:

Row 1: inc in each st (4 sts). Row 2 and every alternate row: P. Row 3: Kfb of first st, k to last st, kfb.

Cont working rows 2 and 3 until 70 sts, changing to circular needle when the sts won't fit of straight needle anymore.

CENTRE:

Row 1: kfb in first st, k to last 2 sts k2tog.

Row 2 and every alt row: P. Repeat these 2 rows once.

LAST CORNER:

Row 1: K2tog at both the beg and end of the row.

Row 2 and every alt row: P.

Repeat these 2 rows util only 2 sts remain then k2tog and fasten.

TASSELS:

Lay out 6×60 cm threads and cut one end only for each of the 4 corners of the blanket.

Draw these threads through an edge stitch on one of each of the 4 corners, until the threads are at a halfway point. Make a simple knot in the middle at the halfway point so that the tassels are approx. 30cm length.

Darn in all loose ends.
