Chunky Sweater

EASY KNIT



Make this fabulous oversize chunky sweater, which is a great project for beginner knitters. Graded for child, tween, teen and adult sizes, all the pieces are knitted flat and seamed, and using our Chunky Sherpa Yarn and big needles, this garment will work up in no time at all.

## MEASUREMENTS

	Child	Tween	Teen	Adult
Chest Width	40cm	48cm	56cm	64cm
Body Length	45cm	48cm	51cm	54cm

## YARN REQUIRED

Makr **CHUNKY SHERPA Yarn 226g balls**

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## DIFFICULTY ●●●

### NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm straight knitting needles  
Removable Stitch Markers  
Stitch Holder

### TENSION:

25mm: 3sts x 4rows = 10cm x 10cm stst.

### KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

Cont Continue.  
K Knit.  
K2tog Knit two stitches together as a decrease method.  
Kfb Knit into the front and the back of the stitch as an increasing method.  
P Purl.  
P2tog Purl two stitches together as a decrease method.  
Pfb Purl into the front and the back of the stitch as an increasing method.  
St(s) Stitch(es).  
Stst Stocking Stitch (alternatively knit 1 row, purl 1 row).

## SWEATER PATTERN

### BACK

Cast on 12(14,16,18) sts,  
Work 10(12,14,16) rows of stst.

Shape Armhole:

Cast off 2 sts, k to end.

Next Row: Pcast off 2 sts, p to end. (8,10,12,14 sts)

Work another 6(8,10,12) rows of stst.

Cast off, placing markers at 3rd (4th, 4th, 5th), and 6th (7th,10th,10th) st, to mark shoulder joins, and back neckline opening.

### FRONT

Cast on 12(14,16,18) sts.

Work 10(12,14,16) rows of stst.

Shape Armhole:

Cast off 2 sts, k to end.

Next Row: Pcast off 2 sts, p to end. (8,10,12,14)

Shape Neckline

1. K4 (5,6,7)sts, turn.
2. P4 (5,6,7)sts.
3. K1, k2tog, k1, turn. 3(4,5,6) sts

Child Size:

4. P3 sts.
5. K3 sts, turn.
6. P3sts.

Cast off.

Tween Size:

- 4. P4 sts.
- 5. K1, k2tog, k1, turn. (3) sts
- 6. P3 sts.
- 7. K3 sts, turn.

Cast off.

Teen Size:

- 4. P5 sts.
- 5. K1, k2tog, k1, turn. (4)sts.
- 6. P4 sts.
- 7. K4 sts, turn.
- 8. P1, p2tog, p1 (3) sts.
- 9. K row, turn.
- 10. P row.

Cast off.

Adult Size:

- 4. P6 sts.
- 5. K1, k2tog, k1, turn. (5) sts.
- 6. P5 sts.
- 7. K5 sts, turn.
- 8. P1, p2tog, p1. (4) sts.
- 9. K row, turn.
- 10. P row.

Cast off.

Take 4(5,6,7) sts that are left on the left hand needle; slide them off onto another needle so you will join thread onto the purl side to begin knitting here.

- 1. P row, turn.
- 2. K row.

Child Size:

- 3. P1, p2tog, p1, turn (3 sts)
- 4. K row.
- 5. P row.
- 6. K row.

Pcast off.

Tween Size:

- 4. P1, p2tog, p1, turn. (4 sts)
- 5. K row.
- 6. P row, turn.
- 7. K1, k2tog, k1, turn. (3 sts)
- 8. P row, turn.

Cast off.

Teen Size:

- 4. P1, p2tog, p1, turn. (5)sts.
- 5. Krow.
- 6. P row, turn.
- 7. K1, k2tog, k (4 sts)
- 8. P row, turn.
- 9. K row.
- 10. P1, p2tog, p1, turn. (3)sts.
- 11. K row.

PCast off.

Adult Size

- 4. P1, p2tog, p1, turn (6)sts.
- 5. K row.
- 6. P row, turn.
- 7. K1, k2tog, k (5 sts)
- 8. P row, turn.
- 9. K row.
- 10. P1, p2tog, p1, turn. (4)sts.
- 11. K row.

PCast off.

**SLEEVES**

(Make 2 the same)

Cast on 8(10,12,14) sts,

Work 4 rows of stst.

5th row: kfb of st, k to last st, kfb. (10,12,14,16) sts

6th -8th(10th, 12th, 14th) row:

cont working in stst.

Shape Armhole:

\*K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (8, 10, 12, 14 sts)

P row.\*

Repeat \* to \* until 4 sts.

Next Row: K1, k2tog, k1.(3 sts)

Next Row: Purl row.

Next Row: K2tog, k1.(2 sts)

Next Row: Purl row

Next Row: K2tog.

**TO MAKE UP**

Using fingers, darn back and front shoulder seams at shoulder joins.

Darn sleeves to armhole apex on front and back.

Darn sleeve sides together.

Darn back, front sides together.

Darn in all ends to neaten.
