CHUNKY VELVET

Textured Lace Scarf

EASY KNIT

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You will love the luxuriousness of this chunky scarf knitted in a textural lace stitch to create a 3-dimensional look and feel. This is a surprisingly easy pattern that will appeal to both beginners and more advance knitters alike, and which works up quickly with big needles, and our plush Chunky Velvet Yarn.

MEASUREMENTS

ONE SIZE

Width	10cm
Length (approx)	200cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr **CHUNKY VELVET** Yarn 500g balls

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm straight knitting needles

TENSION:

25mm: 2.5 sts x 3.5rows = 10cm x 10cm stst.

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

K: knit
P: purl
Sl: slip
St(s): stitch(es)
Yrn: Wrap yarn over the needle to make a stitch.
Yo: Yarn Over: a stitch formed by the yarn being wrapped over the needle.

SCARF PATTERN

Cast on 6 sts.

Rows 1 and 3: p1, *p1, yrn*, repeat * to * to last st, p1.

Row 2: k1, Sl 4 sts to right hand needle letting drop the yarn over's, slip the 4 lengthened sts to left hand needle then (**) insert right hand needle from left to right into these 4 sts, draw through a loop (leave the 4 sts on left hand needle), k this loop (***), rep from (**) to (***) 3 more times; let drop the 4 sts from left hand needle, k1. (6 sts)

Row 4: same as 2nd row .

Repeat until scarf measures approximately 2 metres, or your desired length, and P cast off; taking into consideration that each ball will make a bit more than 1 metre of scarf. Save some yarn for tassels.

TASSELS

Fold 4 strands of yarn approx. 30cm length, and feed half through an edge stitch, then form a small loop. Pull the other half through this loop and gently tighten to make a knot.

Repeat for all other stitches.

Cut ends to make the same length.
