

Velvet Headband

EASY KNIT

Knit this cable twist headband pattern to make a cosy and plush headwarmer for the cold weather months, while still looking stylish and cute. This is an easy grade pattern and perfect for beginners as it is knitted flat, with a joining seam in the back.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size			
Width	15cm		
Circumference	50cm		

YARN REQUIRED

Makr CHUNKY VELVET Yarn 500g balls

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DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm straight knitting needles

TENSION:

25mm: $3sts \times 4rows = 10cm \times 10cm stst.$

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

Cont continue K knit St(s) stitch(es)

Stst stocking stitch; alternatively knit 1 row, purl 1 row

HEADBAND PATTERN

Cast on 8 sts.

Work stst for 12 rows.

Slide sts off the left hand neelde; Place the first 4 stitches back on the needle, then bring the back 4 stitches to sit in front of these 4 sts, in the order of

stitch numbers 8,7,6,5.

K row.

Cont working another 11 rows of stst.

Cast off.

TO FINISH

Using fingers, join the start and end of headband, and darn in loose threads to neaten.

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.
