

Velvet Slippers

EASY KNIT

An easy pattern to make super cosy and plush slippers. Knitted flat and seamed together, this pattern comes together so quickly.

MEASUREMENTS

One Size	
Width	11cm
Length	26cm

YARN REQUIRED

Makr CHUNKY VELVET Yarn 500g balls

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NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EQUIPMENT:

25mm straight knitting needles Stitch Markers x 2

TENSION:

25mm: $3sts \times 4rows = 10cm \times 10cm stst.$

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

Cont continue K knit

K2tog knit 2 stitches together to decrease.

St(s) stitch(es)

Stst stocking stitch; alternatively knit 1 row, purl 1 row

HEADBAND PATTERN

Cast on 8sts.

FOOT:

Work 6 rows stst. Place marker

SHAPE TOE:

K2, k2tog, k2tog, k2 (6 sts)

P row.

K1, k2tog,

K1,k2tog, k2tog, k1 (4 sts)

P row

Cast off. Leave a long thread to darn and make a bow.

TO FINISH HEEL:

Fold cast on edge in half and using fingers seam sides together for the back of the heel.

TO FINISH TOE & FOOT:

Sew up middle seams of toe up to marker.

Tie a cute bow with the left over thread in the middle of the foot opening, weaving it into the stitches to secure.

Darn loose threads to neaten. Trim threads
