

Knitted Baubles

EASY KNIT

Knit these adorable colourful Bauble Ornaments to add festivity all year round. Made with straight needles and the knit stitch, this is a quick and easy project with simple shaping techniques and a joining seam with little hanging loops knitted in Thread as a garland against a wall, window or tree, or hang from loops off a door handle, piece of furniture, a tree or plant. Choose your own two-tone colour combinations or follow ours as a guide.

MEASUREMENTS

YARN REQUIRED

Makr DK Yarn 100g balls

C1	1	
C2	1	

NOTE: This pattern is written in British English. All measurements in charts and instructions are in cm. For conversion from centimetres to inches please divide by 2.5cm. Please be aware that there are different terms for crocheting and knitting in American and British English, if in doubt, we've included a list of common abbreviations.

Please use only the yarn specified. Another yarn is likely to yield different results. Quantities are approximate as knitting styles may vary between knitters. Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

DIFFICULTY • • •

NEEDLES AND EOUIPMENT:

4mm straight knitting needles

Wool Needle and Sullivans Fairy Floss Fill

TENSION:

4mm: 22 sts x 28 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm stst.

KNITTING ABBREVIATION:

C Colour K knit

Kfb knit into the front and the back of the stitch to

increase

K2tog knit two stitches together to decrease

St(s) Stitch(es)

BAUBLES PATTERN

Cast on 2st with C1.

K row

Next row: kfb, kfb (4 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: kfb of ev st (8 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, kfb* repeat to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (12 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, kfb, k1*, repeat to end (16 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, kfb, kfb, k1*, repeat to end (24 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, kfb, k2, kfb, k1* (32 sts)

Next 3 rows: k

Next row: *k1, kfb, k4, kfb, k1* (40 sts)

Next 3 rows: k Change to C2 Next 3 rows: k

Next row: *k1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1* (32 sts)

Next 3 rows: k

Next row: *k1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k1* (24 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, k2tog, k2tog, k1* (16 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: *k1, k2tog, k1* (12 sts)

Next row: k1

Next row: *k1, k2tog* (8 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: k2tog for whole row (4 sts)

Next row: k

Next row: k2tog, k2tog (2 sts)

HANGING LOOPS AND FINISHING

**K2

Slide sts off right hand needle with right side facing onto left needle and draw thread towards start of the row.
Repeat *** to *** 8 times.

To make the loop join to the first **2 sts at the start of loop by picking up each stitch and knit tog with stitch on the needle, then cast off st so you have 1 st left.

Draw thread through last st leaving a long enough thread to sew a close up seam on the side of the ball to halfway.
Feed a handful of fairyfloss to fill the ball.

Change the thread colour to match and continue the seam until closed.

Darn in threads to neaten.
