Sparkle Unicorn Puppet

how to make

Sparkle Unicorn Puppet

DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 1 hour


MATERIALS

- 2 Toilet paper rolls
- Linraft Fairy floss yarn
- Opal white macrame cord
- Sully comic joggle eyes 14 mm
- Makr Tea Tree White paint
- Makr Bottlebrush Red
- Pink card stock
- Foam sheet A3 glitter rose gold
- Arbee wood round bead 30mm
- Polystyrene carrot
- Fuchsia glitter
- Arbee paddle sticks x2

EQUIPMENTS

- Scissors
- Paint brush





STEPS

- 1. Cut ¼ of one of the paper roll and discard. Paint the paper rolls white and allow them to dry. The small one is the head of the unicorn and the large one is the body. Paint the wooden beads bottlebrush red.
- 2. To make the horn, snip the end of the carrot and poke it onto a toothpick. Brush it with PVA glue and sprinkle it with glitter and allow to dry.
- 3. Cut a circle and a strip from the pink card stock. Stick the circle card stock to the end of the head and the strip around the end. Cut 2 nostrils from the glitter paper and glue. Stick joggle eyes in place. Glue the horn onto the unicorn head.
- 3. Following the guide use the hole punch to create holes for the macrame cords.
- 4. Insert the macrame cords into the legs holes and knot them at the top. Tie the painted beads to the end of each macrame cord for the feet. Tie a macrame cord to the top of the body and continuing through the head, to create the neck.
- 5. Insert one cord each in the top of the head and back to create your puppet strings.
- 6. To make the tail and the hair for the unicorn, cut lots of strips of wool and tie them together. Glue them in place.
- 8. Cross over the 2 paddle sticks and glue them in place. Tie the macrame cords at opposite ends of the paddles, and glue in place.
