Sunglass Case

Easy

DIFFICULTY

Easy - Approx. 30 minutes

MATERIALS

Craft Fabric
Yellow Cotton
Batting
Matching Thread

EQUIPMENTS

- Sewing Machine
- Fabric Scissors
- Iron / Ironing Board

STEPS

1. Cut all fabrics to size;

Outside - 18cm x 20cm

Lining - 18cm x 24cm

Batting 18cm x 18cm

2. Place the outside fabric and lining right sides together. Place the batting on top and pin. Sew 2 ½ cm seam allowance, this will be the brim of the sunglass case.

3. Iron the seam flat. Flip the lining on to the back and align the bottom edges and iron flat.

4. Align the 2 seams right sides together. Pin in place. Sew along the edges leaving a 8cm gap for turning. Don't sew directly on the batting. The batting is shorter than the fabric to reduce the bulk.

5. Trim corners. Turn right side out. Sew lining close.

6. Iron flat and tuck lining inside sunglass case.
