



Denim Jeans/overalls

Dylon's new hand dye in Jeans Blue

DMC threads 307, 704, 970, & 601

Sewing Needle

Seed beads

Bugle beads



This is a great renovation project for the non-sewer.

Using warm water and salt, dye the jeans using the Jeans Blue.

Trace a design of your choice onto the jeans.

Thread the needle with 6 strands of cotton. Insert needle from wrong side and lay thread flat along your design line. Remove needle.

Re-thread needle with 1 strand of matching DMC thread. Secure thread at back and bring to the front. Sew small, even stitches over the laid thread and back through the fabric.

When you have covered the design lines rethread the needle with the 6 strands, take to the back and secure. When design has been completely stitched attach beads in random pattern.
