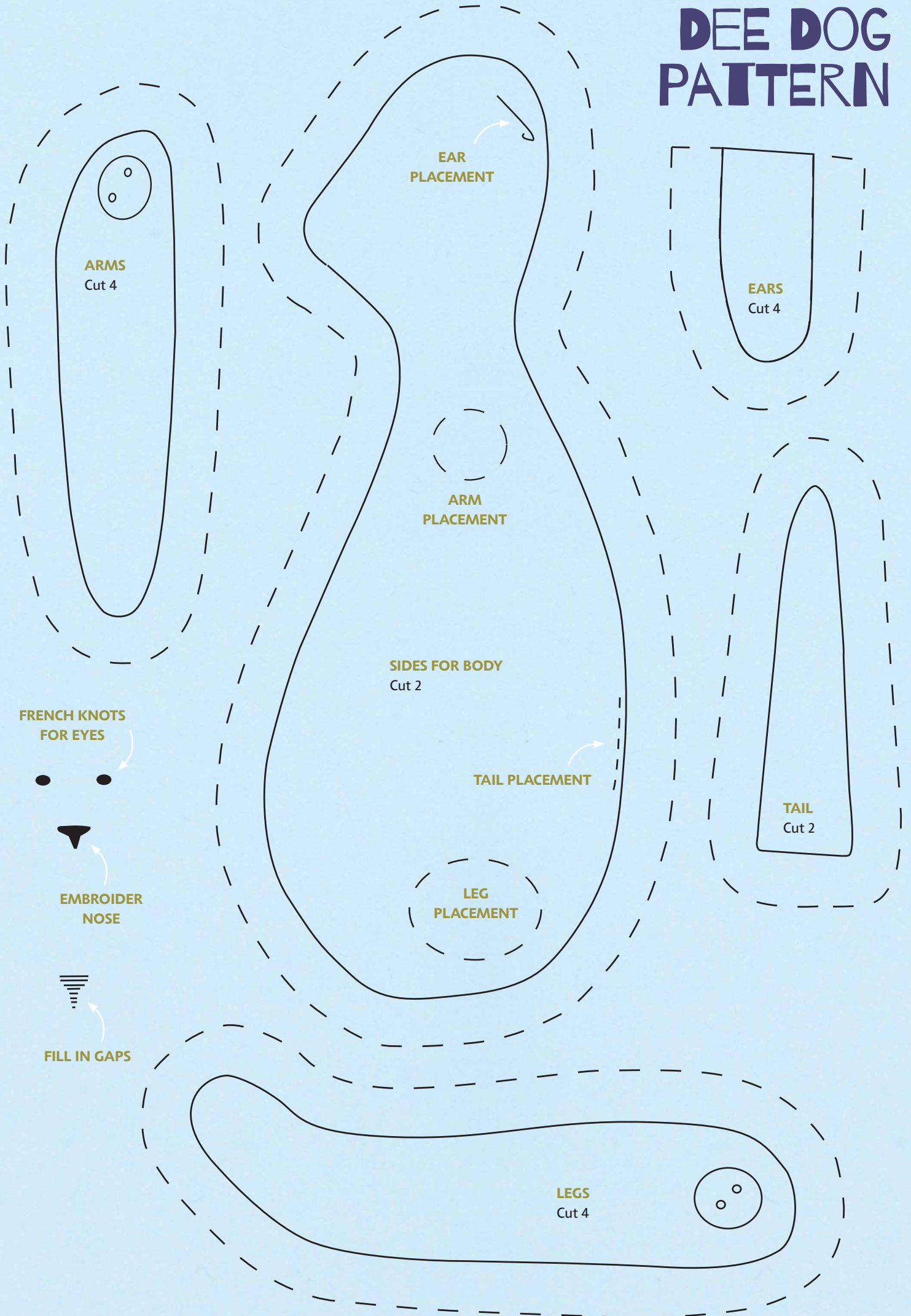

SEW DEE DOG AND FRIENDS

AND KNIT THEM A WARDROBE OF CLOTHES

DEE DOG PATTERN



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS



YOU WILL NEED

- 1 fat quarter of fabric – or 45cm x 55cm of fabric
- Fibrefill
- Embroidery floss
- Needles – 1 x embroidery, 1 x standard
- Sewing machine

STEP 1

Cut out pattern pieces.

STEP 2

With right sides together, sew ears and tail – keeping straight end open for turning. For ears: Turn right side out, and tuck unsewn edge back into the sewn piece. Hand sew opening closed. Reserve tail with unfinished end for next step.

STEP 3

Pin the tail to the body pointing inwards, so that it will protrude when turned right side out. Pin body pieces right together and sew, allowing a space for turning. Pin arm, and leg pieces right side together and sew, allowing a space for turning. Stuff completed pieces, and hand-sew all openings closed.

STEP 4

Tuck one side of the ear under to create a small fold, and hand-sew to the head. The fold should be towards the back of the head. Placement is marked on the pattern piece.

STEP 5

Hand-sew the arms to the body. Sew

around the top of the arm, and then, flip the arm up, and reinforce on the underside.

STEP 6

Hand-sew the legs to the body. Sew around the top of the leg, and then, flip the leg up, and reinforce on the underside.

STEP 7

Embroider eyes and nose. Make eyes by creating 2 long french knots with the thread wrapped around 10x before stitching back in. Do the first knot, then cross the second knot over it. Make nose by sewing long running stitches in a T shape with some vertical stitches to reinforce the shape as needed.

STRIPEY JUMPER

Easy knit

MEASUREMENTS

Length cm 9

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Grand 4ply	100g balls	Small quantity in
OR Lincraft Cotton 4ply	50g balls	Main Colour (MC) and
OR Lincraft Lullaby 4ply	50g balls	Contrast Colour (CC)

NEEDLES

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

BACK

Using 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on 27 sts. Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... 29 sts.

Beg Stripe Patt:

Using CC, work 2 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.
Using MC, work 2 rows stocking st.
Last 4 rows form stripe patt.

Cont in stripe patt until work measures 9cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 4 rows.
Cast off rem 9 sts.

FRONT

Work as for Back until there are 6 rows less

than Back to beg of shoulder shaping.

Shape Neck:

Next row: Keeping stripe patt correct, K13, cast off next 3 sts, knit to end.
Cont on last 13 sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 2 rows, then foll alt row ... 10 sts.
Work 2 rows.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 5 sts.

With wrong side facing, join appropriate coloured yarn to rem 13 sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 2 rows, then foll alt row ... 10 sts.
Work 1 row.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 5 sts.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on 25 sts. Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc one st in centre of last row ... 26 sts.

Working in CC and stocking st for rem, beg with a knit row, cont until Sleeve measures 5cm from beg, ending with a purl row.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves, placing centre of Sleeve to shoulder seam. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.

COMFY PANTS

Easy knit

MEASUREMENTS

Length (approx) cm 13

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Grand 4ply	100g balls	Small quantity
OR Lincraft Cotton 4ply	50g balls	
OR Lincraft Lullaby 4ply	50g balls	

NEEDLES

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

REQUIREMENTS

A stitch holder.

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

PANTS FRONT

1st Leg:

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 14 sts. Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc one st in centre of last row ... 15 sts. Work in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until work measures 7cm from beg, ending with a purl row. **
Leave sts on a stitch holder.

2nd Leg:

Work as given for 1st Leg to **.

Crotch:

1st row: K13, K2tog, slip sts from stitch holder onto left hand needle, sl 1, K1, pss0,

knit to end ... 28 sts. ***

Cont until work measures 12cm from beg, ending with a purl row and dec one st in centre of last row ... 27 sts.

Waistband:

Knit 6 rows garter st.
Cast off.

PANTS BACK

Work as for Pants Front to ***.
Work 5 rows.

Beg Tail Opening:

Next row: K14, turn.
Work 8 rows on these 14 sts.

Break off yarn and leave these 14 sts on a stitch holder.

With right side facing, join yarn to other 14 sts and knit to end.

Work 8 rows on these 14 sts.

Next row: Purl across all 28 sts.

Cont until work measures 12cm from beg, ending with a purl row and dec one st in centre of last row ... 27 sts.

Waistband:

Knit 6 rows garter st.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Join side and leg seams. Sew in all ends.

MEASUREMENTS

Width	cm	2
Length	cm	28

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Grand 4ply	100g balls	
OR Lincraft Cotton 4ply	50g balls	Small quantity
OR Lincraft Lullaby 4ply	50g balls	

NEEDLES

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

27 sts and 55 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 3.25mm needles.

EASY SCARF,

KNITTED LENGTHWAYS

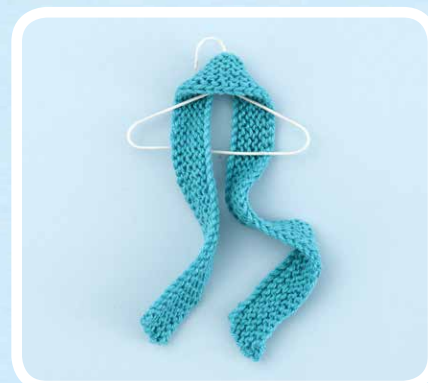
Beginner knit

SCARF

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 76 sts.
Knit in garter st until Scarf measures 2cm from beg.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew in all ends.



HAPPY DRESS

Easy knit

MEASUREMENTS

Length (approx)	cm	14
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YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Grand 4ply	100g balls	
OR Lincraft Cotton 4ply	50g balls	Small quantity
OR Lincraft Lullaby 4ply	50g balls	

NEEDLES

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

DRESS

(Front and Back alike – make 2)

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 31 sts.
Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... 33 sts.
Work 4 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.

Beg Side Shaping:

Cont in stocking st and dec one st at each end of next row, then every 10th row until 25 sts rem.
Work 3 rows.

Shape Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 21 sts.
Next row: K2, K2tog, knit to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.
Next row: K2, purl to last 2 sts, K2.
Rep last 2 rows once ... 17 sts.

Shape Neck:

Next row: K7, cast off next 3 sts, knit to end.

Cont on last 7 sts.

Next row: K2, P3, P2tog.

Next row: K2tog, K4.

Next row: K2, P1, P2tog.

Cast off these 4 sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem 7 sts.

Next row: P2tog, P3, K2.

Next row: K4, K2tog.

Next row: P2tog, P1, K2.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Join shoulder and side seams.
Sew in all ends.



COSY COAT

Easy knit

MEASUREMENTS

Length (approx) cm 11

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby
Grand 4ply 100g balls
OR Lincraft
Cotton 4ply 50g balls Small quantity
OR Lincraft
Lullaby 4ply 50g balls

NEEDLES

A pair of 3.25mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

REQUIREMENTS

4 small buttons.

TENSION

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 3.25mm needles.

BACK

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 31 sts.
Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... 33 sts.
Work 4 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.

Beg Side Shaping:

Cont in stocking st and dec one st at each end of next row, then every 6th row until 25 sts rem.
Work 3 rows.

Shape Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 21 sts.
Dec one st at each end of next row and foll alt row ... 17 sts.
Work 5 rows.

Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows.
Cast off rem 9 sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 17 sts.
Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc 2 sts evenly across last row ... 19 sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K3, purl to end.
Rep last 2 rows once.

Beg Side Shaping:

Keeping garter st edge correct as placed, dec one st at beg of next row, then every 6th row until 15 sts rem.
Work 3 rows.

Shape Armhole:

Keeping garter st edge correct, cast off 2 sts

at beg of next row ... 13 sts.
Dec one st at armhole edge in every alt row until 11 sts rem.

Shape Neck:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row ... 8 sts.
Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 4 sts rem.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 2 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 17 sts.
Knit 3 rows garter st, first row is wrong side.

4th row: K1, yfwd, K2tog, knit to end ... buttonhole.

5th row: Knit and inc 2 sts evenly across ... 19 sts.

6th row: Knit.

7th row: Purl to last 3 sts, K3.
Rep last 2 rows once.

Beg Side Shaping:

Keeping garter st edge correct as placed, dec one st at end of next row, then every 6th row until 15 sts rem, AT SAME TIME, work a buttonhole (as before) in 5th row and foll 10th row.
Work 4 rows.

Shape Armhole:

Keeping garter st edge correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next row ... 13 sts.

Next row: K1, yfwd, K2tog, knit to last 2

sts, K2tog.
Work 1 row.

Shape Neck:

Next row: Cast off 3 sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 8 sts.
Work 1 row.
Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 4 sts rem.
Work 1 row.

Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row.
Work 1 row.
Cast off rem 2 sts.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 25 sts.
Knit 5 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc one st in centre of last row ... 26 sts.
Work in stocking st, beg with a knit row, until Sleeve measures 4cm from beg, ending with a purl row.
Dec one st at each end of next row and foll 4th row ... 22 sts.
Work 3 rows.

Shape Top:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 18 sts.
Dec one st at each end of every row until 6 sts rem.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew in Sleeves. Sew on buttons. Sew in all ends.

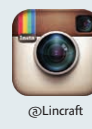
