Lincraft DK 8ply	100g balls

1st Colour (C1 - Chocolate)		1
2nd Colour (C2 - Sky)		1

INTERMEDIATE CROCHET

CROCHET HOOK:

A 3.00mm crochet hook or size needed so that no holes appear in stitches through which stuffing may show.

REQUIREMENTS:

Wool needle for sewing up.
12mm safety eyes.
Lincraft siliconised stuffing premium soft fill.
A stitch marker (highly recommended).

TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

mr = magic ring (alternatively 3ch, sl st into beg ch and dc into ring).

blo = back loop only

bobble = 4 treble stitches worked together. Yarn over, insert hook into stitch and pull up loop, yarn over and pull through two loops (2 loops left on hook), yarn over, insert hook into same st and pull up loop, yarn over and pull through two loops (3 loops left on hook), yarn over, insert hook into same stitch and pull up loop, yarn over and pull through two loops (4 loops left on hook), yarn over, insert hook into same stitch and pull up loop, yarn over and pull through two loops (5 loops left on hook), yarn over and pull through five remaining loops.

HEAD (worked from nose to back of head in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C1, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 3 times ... 9dc.

2nd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 3 times ... 12dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 9dc.

4th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 6dc.

Change to MC.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

6th round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

Stuff nose gently.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

8th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 3 times ... 15dc.

9th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Repeat 9th round once.

11th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 3 times ... 18dc.

12th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

13th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 3 times ... 21dc.

14th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

15th round: 1dc in each of next 6dc, [inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc] 2 times, inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc ... 24dc.

16th round: 1dc in each of next 7dc, [inc in next dc, 1dc in next dc] 5 times, inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc ... 30dc.

17th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

18th round: 1dc in each of next 8dc, [inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc] 5 times, inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc ... 36dc.

19th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

20th round: 1dc in each of next 9dc, [inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 3dc] 5 times, inc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 6dc ... 42dc.

21st round: 1dc in each dc to end.

22nd round: [1dc in each of next 6dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 48dc.

23rd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Change to C1.

24th round: Worked in blo. 1dc in each dc to end.

On section of Head that slopes up, insert 12mm safety eyes between rounds 21-22 approx 8 stitches apart.

25th round: ch1, turn, [1dc in each of next 2dc, bobble in next dc] 16 times ... 48sts.

Continue to work in continuous spirals as instructed, allowing the bobbles to now be on the outside of Head.

26th round: [1htr in each of next 7sts, inc in next st] 6 times ... 54htr.

27th round: [Bobble in next htr, 1dc in each of next 2htr] 18 times ... 54sts.

28th round: 1htr in each stitch to end.

29th round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 18 times ... 54sts.

30th round: 1htr in each stitch to end.

Start to stuff face.

31st round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 18 times ... 54sts.

As you begin decrease rounds, allow work to fold towards you so bobble stitches remain on the outside.

32nd round: [1htr in each of next 7sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 6 times ... 48htr.

33rd round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 16 times ... 48sts.

34th round: [1htr in each of next 6sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 6 times ... 42htr.

35th round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 14 times ... 42sts.

36th round: [1htr in each of next 5sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 6 times ... 36htr.

37th round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 12 times ... 36sts.

38th round: [1dc in each of next 4sts, 1dc over next 2sts] 6 times ... 30dc.

39th round: [1dc over next 2dc, bobble in next dc] 10 times ... 20sts.

40th round: [1dc over next 2sts] 10 times ... 10dc.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Complete stuffing.

Weave tail through last round of dc and gently pull hole closed. Sew in end.

BODY (worked from belly to back in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 10 times ... 40dc.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 10 times ... 50dc.

7th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc, [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc ... 60dc.

8th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

9th round: [1htr in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc, [1htr in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc ... 70sts.

10th round: 1dc in each stitch to end.

11th round: [1htr in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc, [1htr in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc ... 80sts.

12th round: 1dc in each stitch to end.

13th round: [1htr in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc, [1htr in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 5 times, 1dc in each of next 10dc ... 90sts.

Change to C1.

14th round: Worked in blo. 1dc in each stitch to end.

15th round: ch1, turn, [1dc in each of next 2dc, bobble in next dc] 30 times ... 90sts.

Continue to work in continuous spirals as instructed, allowing the bobbles to now be on the outside of Body.

16th round: 1htr in each stitch to end.

17th round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 30 times ... 90sts.

Rep 16th and 17th rounds twice.

22nd round: [1htr in each of next 7sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 10 times ... 80htr.

As you begin decrease rounds, allow work to fold towards you so bobble stitches remain on the outside.

23rd round: [1dc in each of next 2htr, bobble in next htr] 26 times, 1dc in next htr, bobble in next htr ... 80sts.

24th round: [1htr in each of next 6sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 10 times ... 70htr.

25th round: 1dc in next htr, [bobble in next htr, 1dc in each of next 2htr] 23 times ... 70sts.

26th round: [1htr in each of next 5sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 10 times ... 60htr.

27th round: [bobble in next htr, 1dc in each of next 2htr] 20 times ... 60sts.

28th round: [1htr in each of next 4sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 10 times ... 50htr.

29th round: [bobble in next htr, 1dc in each of next 2htr] 16 times, bobble in next htr, 1dc in next htr ... 50sts.

30th round: [1htr in each of next 3sts, 1htr over next 2sts] 10 times ... 40htr.

31st round: [bobble in next htr, 1dc in each of next 2htr] 13 times, bobble in next htr ... 40sts.

32nd round: [1dc in each of next 2sts, 1dc over next 2sts] 10 times ... 30dc.

Start to stuff.

33rd round: [1dc over next 2dc, bobble in next dc] 10 times ... 20dc.

34th round: [1dc over next 2sts] 10 times ... 10dc.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Complete stuffing.

Weave tail through last round of dc and gently pull hole closed. Sew in end.

FRONT FEET (make 2 – worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 3rd round twice.

6th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 12dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

8th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 9dc.

9th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Stuff lightly.

BOTTOM FEET (make 2 – worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 5th round once.

7th round: [1dc in each of next 8dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 27dc.

8th round: [1dc in each of next 7dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 24dc.

9th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

10th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 12dc.

11th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing. Stuff.

EARS (make 2 – worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 12dc.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

ADVANCED CROCHET



MEASUREMENTS

Height	cm	23
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YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft DK 8ply	100g balls	
Main Colour (MC – Buff)		1
1st Colour (C1 – Chocolate)		1
2nd Colour (C2 – Fire Red)		1
3rd Colour (C3 – White)		Small amount
4th Colour (C4 – Apple)		Small amount

SCARF (worked in turned rows, ch at beg is not a stitch)

Using 3.00mm hook and C2, 91ch.

1st row: 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each of next 89ch ... 90dc.

2nd row: ch1, turn, 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 2nd row once.

Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

FLOWER AND LEAF (worked as one piece)

Using 3.00mm hook and C4, 8ch.

1st round: To form Leaf. 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1tr in each of next 3ch, 1htr in next ch, 1dc

in each of next 2ch ... 6sts.

2nd round: To create Flower. 4ch, sl st to beg 4ch to form a ring, 6dc into ring, sl st to beg dc. Keep leaf to back of work ... 6dc.

Change to C3.

3rd round: Petals. [2ch, tr4 into same st, 2ch, sl st into same st, sl st into next dc] 5 times, 2ch, tr4 into same st, 2ch, sl st into same st ... 6 petals. Fasten off and leave tail for sewing. Sew in all other ends.

FINISHING

Pinning before sewing is highly recommended.

Stop and double check placement as you go. Flatten Ear and sew end closed. Sew to top of Head between rounds 27-28 approx 12 stitches apart. Using length of C1, sew Head to top of Body between rounds 14-20. Flatten Front Feet and sew end closed. Sew to front of upper Body between rounds 12-13 approx 20 stitches apart. Stitch down to front of Body. Sew Bottom Feet to front of lower Body between rounds 11-13 approx 8 stitches apart. Wrap Scarf around neck and sew in desired position. Sew Flower and Leaf to top of Head near Ear in desired position. Sew in all ends.

Height cm 26

YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft DK 8ply	100g balls	
Main Colour (MC – Butter)		1
1st Colour (C1 – White)		1
2nd Colour (C2 – Marle bear)		Small amount
3rd Colour (C3 – Fire red)		Small amount
4th Colour (C4 – Gold)		Small amount
5th Colour (C5 – Apple)		Small amount
6th Colour (C6 – Sky)		Small amount

CROCHET HOOK:

A 3.00mm crochet hook or size needed so that no holes appear in stitches through which stuffing may show.

REQUIREMENTS:

Wool needle for sewing up.
12mm safety eyes or 2 small black buttons.
Lincraft siliconised stuffing premium soft fill.
A stitch marker (optional).

TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

mr = magic ring (alternatively 3ch, sl st into beg ch and dc into ring).
blo = back loop only.

HEAD (worked from top of head to bottom of neck as one piece in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 42dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round 12 times.

Change to C2.

20th round: Worked in blo. 1dc in each dc to end. Rep 20th round once.

Change to MC.

22nd round: Worked in blo. 1dc in each dc to end.

23rd round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

24th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Insert 12mm safety eyes between rounds 8-9 approx 8 stitches apart.

Rep 24th round 12 times.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing. Stuff.

NOSE (worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C1, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round twice.

Change to C2.

10th round: Worked in blo. 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 10th round once.

Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

BODY (worked from front to back in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: [1dc in next dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

3rd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

5th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 6 times ... 42dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round 29 times.

Start to stuff.

37th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 36dc.

38th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 30dc.

39th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 24dc.

40th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 18dc.

41st round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 12dc.

42nd round: [1dc over next 2dc] 6 times ... 6dc.

Fasten off. Complete stuffing. Weave tail through dc of last round and gently pull closed. Sew in end.

LEGS (make 4 – worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and C2, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: Inc once in each dc ... 12dc.

2nd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 2nd round once.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 5dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 14dc.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 5th round 8 times.

14th round: [1dc in each of next 6dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 16dc.

15th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

16th round: [1dc in each of next 7dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 18dc.

17th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Repeat 17th round 5 times.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing. Stuff.

EARS (make 2 – worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: 1dc in each dc to end.

2nd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 8dc.

3rd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 10dc.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 12dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

Rep 7th round once.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

TAIL (worked in continuous spirals)

Using 3.00mm hook and MC, work 6dc into mr.

1st round: 1dc in each dc to end.

2nd round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 8dc.

3rd round: 1dc in each dc to end.

4th round: [1dc in each of next 3dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 10dc.

5th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

6th round: [1dc in each of next 4dc, inc in next dc] 2 times ... 12dc.

7th round: 1dc in each dc to end.

8th round: [1dc in each of next 2dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 9dc.

9th round: [1dc in next dc, 1dc over next 2dc] 3 times ... 6dc.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Leave unstuffed.

BLANKET (worked in turned rows, ch at beg is not stitch)

Leave a 10cm beginning and finishing tail after each colour change. These will be tied together to form the tassels.

Using 3.00mm hook and C3, work 31ch.

1st row: 1dc in 2nd ch from hook, 1dc in each of next 29ch ... 30dc.

2nd row: Change to C4. 1ch, turn, 1dc in each dc to end.

3rd row: Change to C5. 1ch, turn, 1dc in each dc to end.

4th row: Change to C6. 1ch, turn, 1dc in each dc to end.

5th row: Change to C3. 1ch, turn, 1dc in each dc to end.

Repeat rows 2-5 3 times.

Fasten off leaving tail.

LEAD

Using 3.00mm hook and C2, work 60ch.

Fasten off and leave tail for sewing.

DECORATIONS (make 4 – worked as one piece)

Using 3.00mm hook and C3, work ch2.

1st round: 4htr in 2nd ch from hook, sl st to beg htr, ch 1.

Fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Repeat using C4, C5, C6 for a total of 4

Decorations.

FINISHING

Pinning before sewing is highly recommended.

Stop and double check placement as you go.

Using a length of C2, embroider Nose details.

Stuff. Sew Nose to front of Head between eyes

and round 20. Flatten Ears and sew end closed.

Pinch bottom of Ears together. Sew to sides of

Head between rounds 6-8 facing forwards

approx 5 stitches back from eyes. Sew Head

to Body between rounds 5-17 adding extra

stuffing if needed before sewing closed.

Sew Legs to underside of Body in a slightly

oval shape. Sew front Legs between rounds 9-16

and rear Legs between rounds 29-36. Add extra

stuffing if needed before sewing closed. Flatten

end of Tail and sew closed. Sew tail to rear of

Body facing down between rounds 36-37.

Position Lead under Nose, around Neck and

back to Nose. Sew in place. Knot Decorations

together at desired length and sew into place

under Nose where Lead meets. In groups of 2,

tie together threads left on blanket sides. Trim to

desired length. Sew Blanket into position on back

of Body using a length of C3. Sew in all ends.

Do not tumble dry. Do not iron. Dry cleanable.

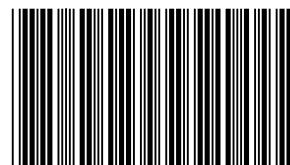
