# LADIES A-LINE SLEEVELESS TOP

EASY KNIT

## MEASUREMENTS

Size		S	M	L	XL
		8-10	12-14	16-18	20-22
Fits bust	cm	80	90	100	110
Garment measures	cm	90	100	110	120
Length	cm	55	56	57	58

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls	6	7	7	8
----------------------	-----------	---	---	---	---

## NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
A 4.00mm circular knitting needle, 40cm long.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## REQUIREMENTS

2 stitch holders.

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BACK

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 116 (128-138-150) sts. Knit 3 rows garter st, first row is wrong side, and inc 6 sts evenly across last row ... 122 (134-144-156) sts. Work 4 rows stocking st, beg with a knit row.

## Beg A-line Shaping:

Cont in stocking st and dec one st at each end of next row, then every 8th row until there are 100 (112-122-134) sts. Cont without shaping until work measures 34cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

## Shape Armholes:

Cast off 6 (8-9-11) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 88 (96-104-112) sts. Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 76 (80-88-92) sts rem. \*\* Cont without shaping until work measures 55 (56-57-58) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

## Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 6 (6-7-7) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 5 (6-7-8) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Leave rem 42 (44-46-48) sts on a stitch holder.

## FRONT

Work as for Back to \*\*. Cont without shaping until there are 32 (34-34-36) rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a purl row.

## Shape Neck:

**Next row:** K28 (29-33-34), turn. Cont on these 28 (29-33-34) sts. Dec one st at neck edge in every alt row until 21 (23-25-27) sts rem, then every 4th row until 17 (18-21-22) sts rem. Purl 1 row.

## Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 6 (6-7-7) sts at beg of next and alt row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 5 (6-7-8) sts. Slip next 20 (22-22-24) sts onto a stitch holder. With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts and knit to end. Dec one st at neck edge in every alt row until 21 (23-25-27) sts rem, then every 4th row until 17 (18-21-22) sts rem. Work 2 rows.

## Shape Shoulder:

Work as for other shoulder shaping.

## NECKBAND

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing and using 4.00mm circular needle, beg at left shoulder seam and knit up 24 (26-26-27) sts along left front neck, knit across sts from Front stitch holder, knit up 24 (26-26-27) sts along right front neck, then knit across sts from Back stitch holder ... 110 (118-120-126) sts.

## 1st round:

Knit. Rep 1st round 8 times. Cast off.

## ARMHOLE BANDS

Join side seams. With right side facing and using 4.00mm circular needle, knit up 106 (114-122-130) sts evenly along armhole edge. Cast off knitways.

## FINISHING

Sew in all ends.

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Cotton 8ply 50g balls

Waist length	7	8	8	9
Long length	9	10	10	11

## NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 97 (109-119-131) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Work a further 6 rows rib.

Work in stocking st until work measures 25cm from beg for Waist Length Jumper or 33cm from beg for Long Length Jumper, ending with a purl row.

## Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 93 (105-115-127) sts.

## Size S Only:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then foll 4th row ... 89 sts.  
Work 1 row.

## Sizes M, L And XL Only:

Dec one st at each end of next 3 rows.  
Work 1 row ... (99-109-121) sts.  
Rep last 4 rows (1-5-8) time/s ... (93-79-73) sts.

## All Sizes:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 53 (55-57-61) sts rem.  
Purl 1 row.  
Cast off.

## SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 61 (65-71-75) sts.  
Work 8 rows rib.

Working in stocking st for rem, inc one st at each end of 5th row, then every 6th (6th-4th-alt) row until there are 67 (77-79-81) sts, then every 8th (8th-6th-4th) row until there are 73 (79-87-97) sts. Cont without shaping until work measures 21cm (or length desired) from beg, ending with a purl row.

## Shape Raglan:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 69 (75-83-93) sts.

## Size S Only:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then foll 4th row ... 65 sts.  
Work 1 row.

## Sizes L And XL Only:

Dec one st at each end of next 3 rows.  
Work 1 row ... (77-87) sts.  
Rep last 4 rows (3-7) times ... (59-45) sts.

## All Sizes:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 29 sts rem.  
Purl 1 row.  
Cast off.

## FINISHING

Join raglan seams. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.

# LADIES LACE SHRUG

## CHALLENGE KNIT

### MEASUREMENTS

Size		S	M	L	XL
		8-10	12-14	16-18	20-22
Fits bust	cm	80	90	100	110
Garment measures	cm	87	97	107	117
Length (approx)	cm	42	43	44	45
Sleeve length	cm	18	18	18	18

### YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls	5	6	6	7
----------------------	-----------	---	---	---	---

### NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
A 4.00mm circular knitting needle, 80cm long.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

### REQUIREMENTS

A stitch holder.

### TENSION

19 sts and 31 rows to 10cm over patt, using 4.00mm needles.

### NOTE

Care must be taken when shaping in this pattern. Do not work the 'yfwd' unless the corresponding 'sl 1, K2tog, pssso' can also be worked, and vice versa.

### BACK

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 87 (95-103-115) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1, \* yfwd, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K1, rep from \* to last 3 sts, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, K1.

**4th row:** Purl.

Last 4 rows form patt.

Work a further 54 rows patt.

### Shape Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 6 (7-7-9) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 75 (81-89-97) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 65 (69-75-79) sts rem.

Work 51 (53-53-53) rows patt.

### Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 6 (7-7-7) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 7 (6-8-8) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Leave rem 27 (29-31-35) sts on a stitch holder.

### LEFT FRONT

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 19 (23-27-31) sts.

Work 5 rows patt.

Keeping patt correct as placed and working extra sts into patt as they become available, cast on 2 (2-2-3) sts at beg of next and alt row ... 23 (27-31-37) sts.

Inc one st at front edge in next row, then every 4th row until there are 35 (39-43-49) sts.

Work 5 rows patt.

### Shape Armhole And Front Slope:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 6 (7-7-9) sts at beg of next row ... 29 (32-36-40) sts.

Dec one st at armhole edge in every alt row 5 (6-7-9) times, AT SAME TIME, dec one st at front edge in 2nd row, then every 14th (12th-10th-8th) row until 20 (21-24-24) sts rem, then every 16th (14th-12th-10th) row until 19 (20-22-22) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

### Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 6 (7-7-7) sts at beg of next and alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 7 (6-8-8) sts.

### RIGHT FRONT

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 19 (23-27-31) sts.

Work 4 rows patt.

Keeping patt correct as placed and working extra sts into patt as they become available, cast on 2 (2-2-3) sts at beg of next and alt row ... 23 (27-31-37) sts.

Work 1 row.

Inc one st at front edge in next row, then every 4th row until there are 35 (39-43-49) sts.

Work 6 rows patt.

### Shape Armhole And Front Slope:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 6 (7-7-9) sts at beg of next row ... 29 (32-36-40) sts.

Dec one st at armhole edge in next row, then every alt row 4 (5-6-8) times, AT SAME TIME, dec one st at front edge in next row, then every 14th (12th-10th-8th) row until 20 (21-24-24) sts rem, then every 16th (14th-12th-10th) row until 19 (20-22-22) sts rem.

Work 2 rows.

### Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 6 (7-7-7) sts at beg of next and alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 7 (6-8-8) sts.

### SLEEVES

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 67 (73-79-85) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Work a further 7 rows rib.

**10th row:** Rib 3 (3-7-5), \* rib 2tog, rib 6 (5-7-6), rep from \* to end ... 59 (63-71-75) sts.

Work 4 rows patt.

Keeping patt correct as placed and working extra sts into patt as they become available, inc one st at each end of next row, then every 24th (12th-12th-8th) row until there are 63 (69-77-83) sts. Cont in patt without shaping until work measures 18cm (or length desired) from beg, working last row on wrong side.

### Shape Top:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 (4-4-5) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 57 (61-69-73) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every 4th (4th-alt-alt) row until 53 (57-21-25) sts rem, then every alt (alt-every-every) row until 15 sts rem.

Work 1 (1-0-0) row/s.

Cast off.

### RIB EDGING

Join shoulder and side seams.

With right side facing and using 4.00mm circular needle, beg at right side seam and knit up 20 (24-28-34) sts along Right Front cast on edge, knit up 46 (46-46-48) sts to beg of Right Front slope shaping, knit up 47 (50-51-54) sts along Right Front slope to shoulder, knit across sts from Back stitch holder and inc 4 (4-4-2) sts evenly across, knit up 47 (50-51-54) sts along Left Front from shoulder to beg of front slope shaping, knit up 46 (46-46-48) sts along Left Front to cast on edge, knit up 20 (24-28-34) sts along Left Front cast on edge, then knit up 95 (107-117-129) sts along Back cast on edge ... 352 (380-402-438) sts.

**1st round:** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st round 8 times.

Cast off loosely in rib.

### FINISHING

Join Sleeve seams. Sew in Sleeves. Sew in all ends.







## MEASUREMENTS

Length (when knitted)	cm	55	56	57	58
Sleeve length (when knitted)	cm	15	15	15	15

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls	10	10	11	12
----------------------	-----------	----	----	----	----

## NEEDLES

A pair of 5.00mm knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## TENSION

18 sts and 25 rows to 10cm over patt, using 5.00mm needles.  
This Cardigan is worked on larger needles and at a looser tension than usually recommended.

## NOTE

This eyelet stitch will slant to the right.

## BACK

Using 5.00mm needles, cast on 129 (**137-147-155**) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* yfwd, K2tog, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** Purl.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 55 (**56-57-58**) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Cast off.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 5.00mm needles, cast on 63 (**67-73-77**) sts.

Work in patt until work measures same as Back, ending with a purl row.

Cast off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front.

## SLEEVES

Using 5.00mm needles, cast on 75 (**77-81-85**) sts.

Work in patt until work measures 15cm (or length desired) from beg, ending with a purl row.

Cast off.

## FINISHING

If desired, block each piece to remove the slanting effect. Join Back and Front cast off edges tog. Measure 21 (**22-23-24**) cm down from the seam and place a marker on Back and Fronts. Sew in Sleeves between markers. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.

**alt:** alternate  
**beg:** beginning  
**cm:** centimetre

**mm:** millimetre

**M1:** make one by picking up the loop between 2 stitches & knitting into the back of it (thereby increasing without using up a stitch).

**P:** purl  
**patt:** pattern  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over  
**p2sso:** pass the two slip stitches over

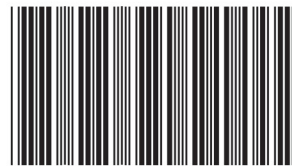
**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**st/s:** stitch/es  
**tbl:** through back of loop  
**tog:** together
