# Seed Stitch Pants with Rib Bands

Easy Knit

## MEASUREMENTS

Months		0	3	6	12
Fits waist	cm	35	40	45	50
Length (approx)	cm	28	32	37	43

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Merino 8ply 50g balls	3	3	4	5
-------------------------------------	---	---	---	---

## NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## REQUIREMENTS

A stitch holder.  
Hat elastic.

## TENSION

21 sts and 38 rows to 10cm over seed st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BACK AND FRONT (make 2)

### First Leg:

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 27 (29-31-35) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Work a further 8 rows rib and dec one st in centre of last row

... 26 (28-30-34) sts.

### Beg Seed St:

**1st row:** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row:** \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form seed st.

Cont in seed st until work measures 11 (13-17-21) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side. \*\*

Leave sts on a stitch holder.

### Second Leg:

Work as for First Leg to \*\*.

### Crotch:

**1st row:** Patt 24 (26-28-32), K2tog, slip sts from stitch holder onto left hand needle, sl 1, K1, pss0, patt to end ... 50 (54-58-66) sts.

Cont in seed st until work measures 25 (29-34-40) cm from beg, working last row on right side.

**Next row:** Patt 4 (2-1-4), \* work 2tog, patt 3 (6-7-5), rep from \* to last 6 (4-3-6) sts, work 2tog, patt 4 (2-1-4) ... 41 (47-51-57) sts.

Work 10 rows rib.

Cast off in rib.

## FINISHING

Join side and leg seams. Thread hat elastic through the 4th, 6th and 8th rows of waistband, on the wrong side. Sew in all ends.



# Babies Seed Stitch Jumper with Pocket & Hood

Intermediate Knit

## MEASUREMENTS

Months		0	3	6	12
Fits chest	cm	35	40	45	50
Garment measures	cm	41	46	52	58
Length	cm	22	26	29	33
Sleeve length	cm	11	13	16	19

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Merino 8ply	50g balls	4	5	6	7
---------------------------	-----------	---	---	---	---

## NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## REQUIREMENTS

A stitch holder.

## TENSION

21 sts and 38 rows to 10cm over seed st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 47 (53-59-65) sts.

**1st row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Work a further 10 (10-14-14) rows rib and dec 3 sts evenly across last row ... 44 (50-56-62) sts.

## Beg Seed St:

**1st row:** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

**2nd row:** \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Last 2 rows form seed st. \*\*

Cont in seed st until work measures 12 (15-17-20) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Armholes:

Keeping seed st correct, cast off 2 (2-3-3) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 40 (46-50-56) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 36 (42-46-50) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until work measures 22 (26-29-33) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Shoulders:

Cast off 3 (4-4-5) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 3 (3-4-4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 18 (20-22-22) sts in seed st.

## FRONT

Work as for Back to \*\*.

Work 2 rows seed st.

## Beg Front Flap For Pocket:

**Next row:** Patt 38 (46-51-57), turn.

**Next row:** Patt 32 (42-46-52), turn.

Cont on these 32 (42-46-52) sts for pocket.

Work 2 rows.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 16 (18-20-24) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a stitch holder.

With right side facing, join yarn to beg of second group of sts, cast on 32 (42-46-52) sts (for back of pocket), patt to end ... 44 (50-56-62) sts.

Work 19 (27-29-31) rows across all 44 (50-56-62) sts.

**Next row:** Patt 14 (16-18-19), place stitch holder for pocket at front of work and patt next st from pocket front and next st from pocket back tog 16 (18-20-24) times, patt to end ... 44 (50-56-62) sts.

Cont in seed st until work measures same as Back to beg of armhole shaping, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Armholes:

Keeping seed st correct, cast off 2 (2-3-3) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 40 (46-50-56) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 36 (42-46-50) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until there are 20 rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Neck:

**Next row:** Patt 14 (16-18-20), cast off next 8 (10-10-10) sts in seed st, patt to end.

Cont on the last 14 (16-18-20) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every alt row until 12 (14-15-17) sts rem, then every 4th row until 9 (11-12-14) sts rem.

Work 4 (4-2-2) rows.

## Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 3 (4-4-5) sts at beg of next and alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 (3-4-4) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every alt row until 12 (14-15-17) sts rem, then every 4th row until 9 (11-12-14) sts rem.

Work 3 (3-1-1) row/s.

## Shape Shoulder:

Work as for other shoulder shaping.

## SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 29 (31-33-35) sts.

Work 10 (10-12-12) rows rib and dec one st in centre of last row ... 28 (30-32-34) sts.

Work 4 rows seed st.

Keeping seed st correct as placed and working extra sts into seed st, inc one st at each end of next row, then every alt (4th-6th-8th) row until there are 32 (34-36-44) sts, then every 4th (6th-8th-10th) row until there are 38 (40-42-46) sts. Cont without shaping until work measures 11 (13-16-19) cm (or length desired) from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Top:

Keeping seed st correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 34 (36-38-42) sts.

## Sizes 3, 6 And 12 Months Only:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then foll 4th row ... (32-34-38) sts.

Work 1 row.

## All Sizes:

Dec one st at each end of next row, then every alt row until 8 sts rem.

Cast off in seed st.

## POCKET EDGING

With right side facing and using 4.00mm needles, knit up 15 (21-23-29) sts along one side edge of pocket.

Work 7 rows rib, beg with a 2nd row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Rep for other side of pocket.

## HOOD

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 81 (93-103-115) sts.

Work 8 rows rib and dec 3 (5-5-5) sts evenly across last row ... 78 (88-98-110) sts.

Work in seed st until work measures 10 (11-12-13) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Back Of Hood:

**Next row:** Patt 39 (44-49-55), turn.

Cont on these 39 (44-49-55) sts.

Keeping seed st correct, dec one st at end of every alt row until 36 (41-46-52) sts rem, then at same edge in every row until 33 (38-43-49) sts rem.

Cast off loosely in seed st.

Join yarn to rem 39 (44-49-55) sts and patt to end.

Dec one st at beg of every alt row until 36 (41-46-52) sts rem, then at same edge in every row until 33 (38-43-49) sts rem.

Cast off loosely in seed st.

## FINISHING

Join shoulder, side and Sleeve seams. Sew in

Sleeves. Sew pocket base and Pocket Edgings

in position. Join centre back seam of Hood.

Sew Hood in position, beg and ending at centre

front neck. Sew in all ends.





# Babies Garter Stitch Raglan Jacket

Easy Knit

## MEASUREMENTS

Months		0	3	6	12
Fits chest	cm	35	40	45	50
Garment measures	cm	41	46	52	58
Length (approx)	cm	22	26	29	33
Sleeve length	cm	11	13	16	19

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Merino 8ply	50g balls	3	4	5	6
---------------------------	-----------	---	---	---	---

## NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.  
Wool needle for sewing up.

## REQUIREMENTS

A button.

## TENSION

21 sts and 43 rows to 10cm over garter st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 45 (**51-57-63**) sts.  
Knit in garter st, first row is wrong side, until work measures 11 (**14-16-18**) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 41 (**47-53-59**) sts.  
Dec one st at each end of next row, then every 6th (**4th-alt-alt**) row until 31 (**21-47-53**) sts rem, **Sizes 0, 6 And 12 Months Only:** then every 4th row until 21 (**23-25**) sts rem.  
Knit 1 row.  
Cast off rem sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 23 (**26-29-32**) sts.  
Knit in garter st, first row is wrong side, until work measures same as Back to beg of raglan shaping, working last row on wrong side. \*\*

## Shape Raglan Armhole:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row ... 21 (**24-27-30**) sts.  
Dec one st at armhole edge in 2nd row, then every 6th (**4th-alt-alt**) row 4 (**8-2-2**) times, **Sizes 0, 6 And 12 Months Only:** then every 4th row 1 (**8-9**) time/s ... 15 (**15-16-18**) sts.

## Shape Neck:

Cast off 5 (**5-6-6**) sts, knit to end ... 10 (**10-10-12**) sts.  
Dec one st at armhole edge in 3rd row, then every 4th row 3 (**3-3-4**)

times, AT SAME TIME, dec one st at neck edge in next row, then every 4th row 2 (**2-2-3**) times, then every 6th row once ... 2 sts.  
Knit 1 row.

**Next row:** K2tog. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front to \*\*.  
Knit 1 row.

## Shape Raglan Armhole:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row ... 21 (**24-27-30**) sts.  
Dec one st at armhole edge in next row, then every 6th (**4th-alt-alt**) row 4 (**7-2-2**) times, **Sizes 6 And 12 Months Only:** then every 4th row (**7-8**) time/s ... 16 (**16-17-19**) sts.

Knit 1 row.

**Next row:** K2, yfwd, K2tog, knit to end ... buttonhole.

Knit 1 row.

## Shape Neck:

**Next row:** Cast off 5 (**5-6-6**) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 10 (**10-10-12**) sts.

Dec one st at armhole edge in every 4th row 4 (**4-4-5**) times, AT SAME TIME, dec one st at neck edge in 2nd row, then every 4th row 2 (**2-2-3**) times, then every 6th row once ... 2 sts.

Knit 1 row.

**Next row:** K2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 27 (**29-31-33**) sts.  
Knitting in garter st, first row is wrong side, inc one st at each end of 12th row, then every 4th (**6th-10th-8th**) row until there are 31 (**33-37-39**) sts, then every 6th (**8th-12th-10th**) row until there are 37 (**39-41-47**) sts.  
Cont without shaping until work measures 11 (**13-16-19**) cm (or length desired) from beg, working last row on wrong side.

## Shape Raglan:

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 33 (**35-37-43**) sts.  
Dec one st at each end of next row, then every 4th row until 11 (**11-11-15**) sts rem, then every alt row until 7 sts rem.  
Knit 1 row.  
Cast off rem sts.

## FINISHING

Join raglan seams, noting that tops of Sleeves form part of neckline.  
Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew on button. Sew in all ends.

# Stroller, Crib & Throw Size Blankets

Easy Knit

## MEASUREMENTS

Size		Stroller	Crib	Throw
Width (approx)	cm	58	84	97
Length (approx)	cm	82	114	98

## YARN REQUIRED

Lincraft Baby Merino 8ply	50g balls	7	15	15
---------------------------	-----------	---	----	----

## NEEDLES

A 4.00mm circular knitting needle.  
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

## TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## BLANKET

Using 4.00mm circular needle, cast on 122 (176-204) sts.

**Note:** A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work backwards and forwards in rows, not rounds.

Knit 12 rows garter st, and inc 2 (4-4) sts evenly across last row ... 124 (180-208) sts.

### Beg Triangle Patt 1:

**1st and alt rows:** Knit.

**2nd row:** K6, [K13, P1] 4 (6-7) times, [P1, K13] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**4th row:** K6, [K11, P3] 4 (6-7) times, [P3, K11] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**6th row:** K6, [K9, P5] 4 (6-7) times, [P5, K9] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**8th row:** K6, [K7, P7] 4 (6-7) times, [P7, K7] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**10th row:** K6, [K5, P9] 4 (6-7) times, [P9, K5] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**12th row:** K6, [K3, P11] 4 (6-7) times, [P11, K3] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**14th row:** K6, [K1, P13] 4 (6-7) times, [P13, K1] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

Rep last 14 rows 9 (13-11) times.

### Beg Triangle Patt 2:

**1st and alt rows:** Knit.

**2nd row:** K6, [K1, P13] 4 (6-7) times, [P13, K1] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**4th row:** K6, [K3, P11] 4 (6-7) times, [P11, K3] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**6th row:** K6, [K5, P9] 4 (6-7) times, [P9, K5] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**8th row:** K6, [K7, P7] 4 (6-7) times, [P7, K7] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**10th row:** K6, [K9, P5] 4 (6-7) times, [P5, K9] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**12th row:** K6, [K11, P3] 4 (6-7) times, [P3, K11] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

**14th row:** K6, [K13, P1] 4 (6-7) times, [P1, K13] 4 (6-7) times, K6.

Rep last 14 rows 9 (13-11) times.

Knit 12 rows garter st and dec 2 (4-4) sts evenly across first row ...

122 (176-204) sts.

Cast off.

## FINISHING

Sew in all ends. Block the Blanket so the edges lie flat.





## LINCRAFT BABY MERINO 8PLY

**Composition:** 100% Australian Merino Wool

**Weight:** 50g

**Meterage:** 84m

**Needle Size:** 4.00mm

**Tension (10cm x 10cm):** 22 stitches x 30 rows

**Care Instructions** - Wash Separately. Cool Hand Wash. Lie Flat To Dry. Do Not Bleach/ Soak/ Tumble Dry. Cool Iron. Dry cleanable (P).

## KNITTING ABBREVIATIONS

**alt:** alternate  
**beg:** beginning  
**cm:** centimetre  
**cont:** continue  
**dec:** decrease  
**foll:** following  
**inc:** increase  
**incl:** including  
**K:** knit  
**mm:** millimetre

**M1:** make one by picking up the loop between 2 stitches & knitting into the back of it (thereby increasing without using up a stitch).

**P:** purl  
**patt:** pattern  
**pssso:** pass slip stitch over  
**p2sso:** pass the two slip stitches over

**rem:** remaining  
**rep:** repeat  
**st/s:** stitch/es  
**tbl:** through back of loop  
**tog:** together  
**ybk:** yarn back  
**yft:** yarn front  
**yfwd:** yarn forward  
**yon:** yarn over needle  
**yrn:** yarn around needle
