MEASUREMENTS

Fits chest/bust	cm	63	68	75	80	85	90
Garment measures (at chest)	cm	103	108	125	130	145	150
Length (approx)	cm	46	50	54	56	57	58
Sleeve length	cm	23	27	30	30	30	30
Yarn Required:							
Lincraft Cotton 8ply	50g balls						
1st Colour (C1-green)		6	7	8	9	10	11

3rd Colour (C3-coral)		1	1	2	2	2	2

DIFFICULTY ●●●

NEEDLES

A pair of 4.00mm knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing up.

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

Using 4.00mm needles and C1, cast on 107 (113-131-137-153-159) sts.

1st row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form rib.

Work a further 8 (8-10-10-12-14) rows rib.

Work in stocking st until work measures 31 (33-35-36-36-36) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Armholes:

Cast on 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 115 (121-139-145-161-167) sts.

Work 4 rows.

Beg Stripe Patt:

Using C2, work 2 rows stocking st.

Using C3, work 2 rows stocking st.

Last 4 rows form stripe patt.

Cont in stripe patt until work measures 43 (47-51-53-54-55) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Using C1 for rem, work 2 rows rib.

Shape Shoulders:

Keeping rib correct, cast off 8 (9-11-12-13-14) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then 10 (9-11-11-15-15) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 47 (49-51-51-53-53) sts loosely in rib.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles and C1, cast on 39 (41-43-47-47-49) sts.

Work 10 (10-12-12-14-16) rows rib.

Working in stocking st, inc one st at each end of 5th row, then every alt row until there are 43 (47-57-65-77-83) sts, then every 4th row until there are 63 (73-81-85-91-95) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 23 (27-30-30-30-30) cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Top:

Cast off 6 (8-8-9-10-10) sts at beg of next 6 rows,

then 8 (7-10-9-9-11) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 11 (11-13-13-13-13) sts.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew in all ends.
