



Fabric (per metre)

Quilt cover fasteners, buttons or velcro

Thread to match

Sewing machine

Tape measure

Bolsters and pins



QUANTITIES OF FABRIC NEEDED:

Size	Finished size	Cut 2 pieces
Single bed	40cm x 210cm	145cm x 225cm
King Single	160cm x 210cm	165cm x 225cm
Double bed	180cm x 210cm	187cm x 225cm
Queen bed	210cm x 210cm	215cm x 225cm
King bed	245cm x 210cm	250cm x 225cm

Cut two pieces of fabric to the correct size as required, taking into account that fabric may need joining depending on the width. If so it is better to have a central panel and two narrow side panels.

With right sides facing each other, pin the top and side edges and stitch together, leaving a 1.5cm seam allowance. Either over lock or finish seams and clip the corners.

Bottom edge

Finish the bottom edges by double folding a 5cm hem and stitching. Pin bottom seam together leaving a centre opening of 100cm. Stitch each side in place using a 1cm seam allowance.

Using quilt fasteners, buttons and button holes or Velcro, sew in place at 10cm intervals across the opening, 1cm in from the edge.
