

What's needed:

One 100g ball of Cosy Wool by Lincraft

**One pair each of 3.25mm and 4mm
knitting needles**

Tension:

Stocking stitch using 4mm needles
22sts x 30 rows = 10cm (4ins)



Ridge pattern = Rows 1 – 7: knit. Row 8: Purl These 8 rows form pattern. Using 3.25mm needles cast on 115 sts and work in Ridge pattern for 11 rows.

Next row: K5 *inc into next st, K7, rep from * to last 6sts, inc into next st, K5 (129sts) Change to 4mm needles and work 6 rows in patt as before.

Next row: K7sts, M1 into 8thst, K1, M1 [K13, M1 into 14thst, K1, M1] repeat sts in brackets 7times, K7 (145sts) work 9 rows of pattern.

Next row: K8, M1 into 9thst, K1, M1 [K15, M1 into 16thst, K1, M1] repeat sts in brackets 7times, K8 (161sts) work 9 rows of pattern. **Next row:** K9, sl 2 tog, K1, p2sso, (K17, sl 2tog, K1 p2sso) 7 times, K9, (145 sts) Work 3 rows of pattern straight. **Next row:**

K8, sl 2 tog, K1, p2sso (K15, sl 2tog, K1. p2sso) 7 times, K8 (129sts) Work 3 rows of pattern straight.

Next row: K7, sl 2 tog, K1, p2sso, (K13, sl 2tog, K1, p2sso) 7 times, K7 (113sts)

Keeping pattern correct, cont to dec 16sts in this way on every foll 4th row until 33 sts rem.

Next row: Work 1 st, *sl 2 tog, work 1 st, p2sso, work 1 st, rep from * to end (17sts)

Break yarn, thread through rem 17 sts, draw up firmly and fasten off. **Make up:** Using the yarn needle sew in all loose ends and with right sides facing sew the two sides together. **Tassel:** Cut a piece of cardboard 10cm long and wide. Wind the yarn around the cardboard approximately 25 times and cut off. Cut a piece of yarn and thread it through the top and tie off tightly, cut the threads at the other end. Wind another piece of yarn around the 'neck' of the tassel.
