

You will need

1 fancy toggle clasp

9 aqua bicones - 8 to 10mm

40 clear beads - 4mm

12 Aqua bicone - 4mm

14 x 1cm lengths of thin to medium link chain

3 jump rings - 6mm

1 jump ring - 8mm

3 head pins

20 eye pins

Round nose pliers

Flat nose pliers

Side cutters pliers

Front dangles: 3 short lengths of chain and an assortment of 4mm - 10mm beads

Insert one 4mm aqua bicone and one 4mm clear bead on an eye pin, trim approx 8mm from the bead and form a loop with round nose pliers, make 8 of these (set A)

Insert one 4mm clear bead, a 10mm aqua bicone and another 4mm clear bead on an eye pin and form a loop, make 7 of these (set B)

Connect them in this order: 1 A, then 1 cm of chain, then 1 B, keep going in this order until they are all used. This is done by opening and closing the eye pin loops. You should start and end with set A

Cut 2 x 5mm lengths of chain and attach one to each "A set" on the ends

And attach a jump ring to each end.

Connect both parts of the toggle to the jump rings on each end.

Front dangles: Prepare 3 head pins with assorted beads, trim and form a loop

Prepare 5 eye pins with assorted beads, make 3 dangles out of short lengths of chain and assorted beads, put the head pinned beads on the bottom.

Make all 3 slightly different lengths and attach them to an 8mm jump ring, attach the jump ring with the dangles to the bottom of the toggle clasp.
