How does WebRail compare to 2x4's or cable?

- Provides both passive and active fall protection
- Allows up to 4 workers to tie off between a single span of webbing
- Installs faster - up to 60 ft. in less than 10 minutes with two workers
- Reusable and more environmentally friendly than wood
- Lowest cost over the lifespan of the product
- Highest weight rating - 20,000 lbs.

How durable is the webbing?

- Strong enough to stop big machinery
- Interwoven with mono-filament fiber adding strength and durability
- Proven to withstand years of UV rays and salt without degradation
- Resistant to fire allowing welders to safely work nearby
- Maintains strength even with vertical cuts of 1/2"

What's included in the WebRail kit?

Everything needed to cover 180 linear feet:

- (1) Terminating Post
- (6) Column Towers with 30 ft. web rolls
- (6) Spring Tensioner Gauges
- (12) Intermediate Posts
- (14) Self-Recoiling Column Ratchet Binders
- (1) Stackable Pallet Organizer

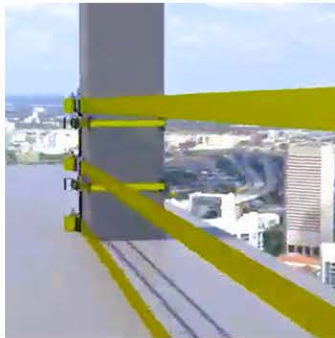


INSTALLATION:

1 Wrap binder straps around the columns



2 Extend straps between columns and tighten



3 Secure intermediate posts every 10 ft
