The alpaca lives on the world's roof in the Andes, where it adapts to temperatures fluctuating from -20 degrees Celcius to +30 degrees Celcius in less than 24 hours. The alpaca's fantastic fur consists of soft airfilled fibres that insulates against both heat and

Wool

Wool is a unique, natural product with endless possibilities. For three generations Silkeborg Uldspinderi has handled wool, from the finest, lightest and softest qualities to coarse and heavy wool. All wool types insulate against both heat and cold. They are naturally dirt repellent and have antibacterial capacities.

The production process from raw wool to the end product requires careful handling with respect for the origins of the wool and the sheep the wool comes from.





Karin



The yarns blend in a slightly flecked expression which brings the throw to life neatly.









The quality is silky and soft in 100% wool which falls neatly. Unlike most wool throws, the Daria has not been brushed after weaving. This gives the throw a clean feel, where the shades and patterns appear clearly.



Maria is a clean mix of classic checks and colour block design. The colours blend when woven together in large solid blocks. The expression changes across the surface, when the different colours meet and blend into new shades.

It is woven from 100% worsted wool yarn in a nice warm and soft quality.


The Nilsen thow is a contemporary minimal design with only 3 slanted lines crossing the otherwise solid surface.

It is double faced, showing different colours on each side which means that you can use it for either a strong colourful expression or pare it down, showing the more subdued side.


















Monica




Julia



Tesa is available on a grey and a white warp.











Baby Alpaca

The alpaca fibres are carefully divided in different categories dependent on their fineness. The finer and thinner the fiber, the higher the quality. Contrary to what one might think the term Baby Alpaca has nothing to do with the age of the animal, but simply names how thin and flexible the fibre is.

We have chosen to use both Baby Alpaca and Premium Baby Alpaca. The Premium Baby Alpaca is the finer of the two, consisting of the finest and softest fibres.



Available in pure solid colours and melanges.







The alpaca lives in the mountain climate of the Andes, where the temperature is high in the day and low at night. Its airy fibers ensure a constant comfortable temperature.





























Scarves


