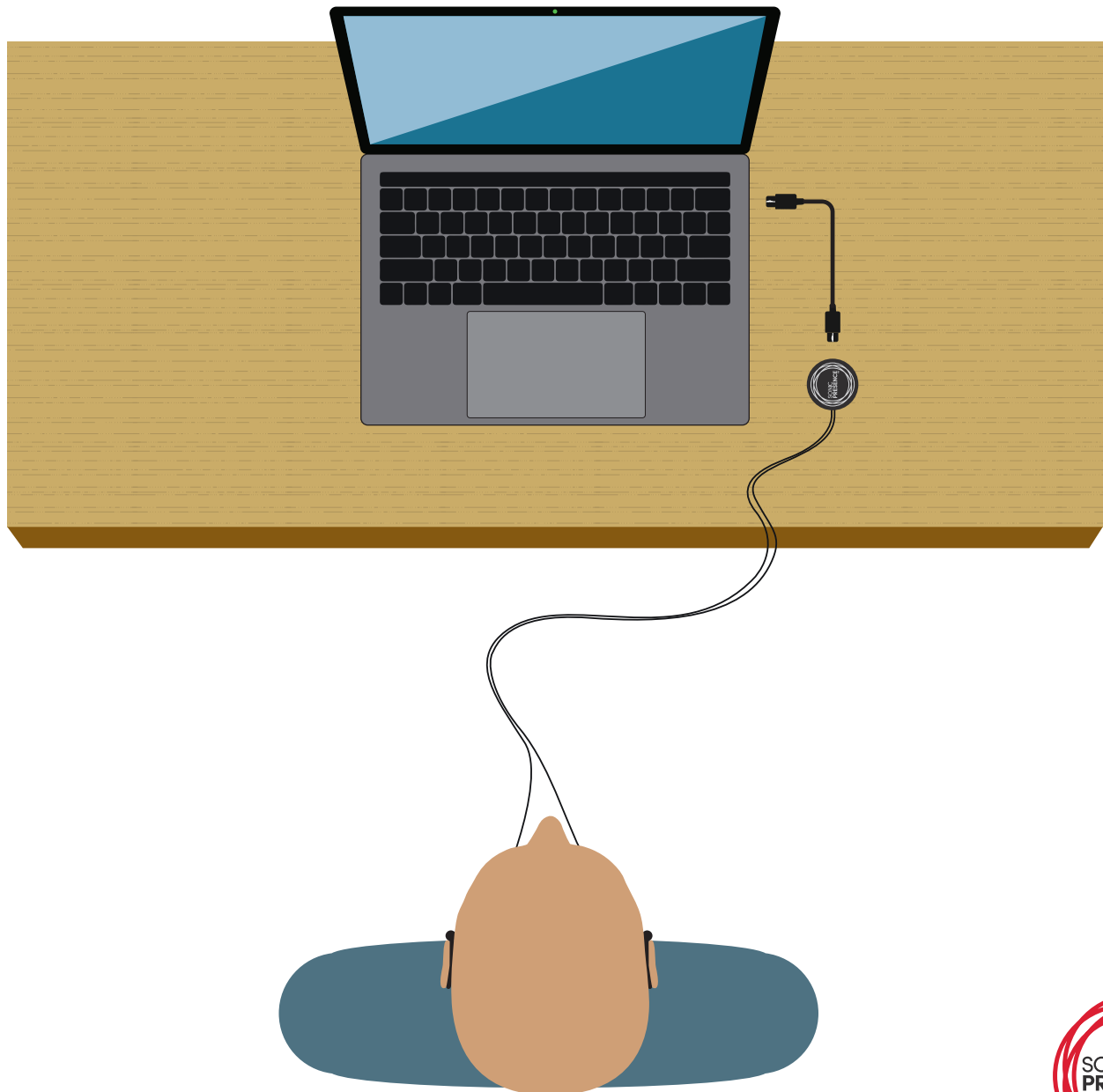

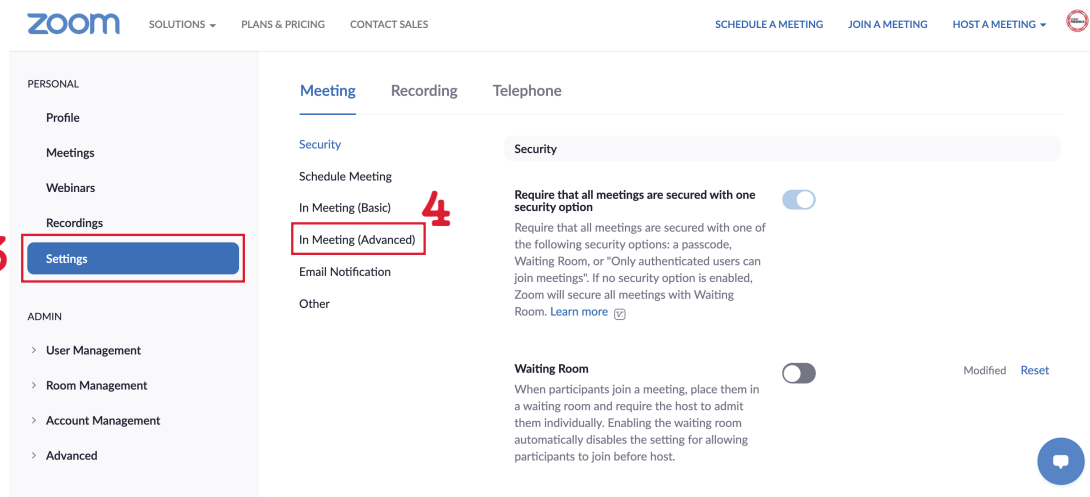

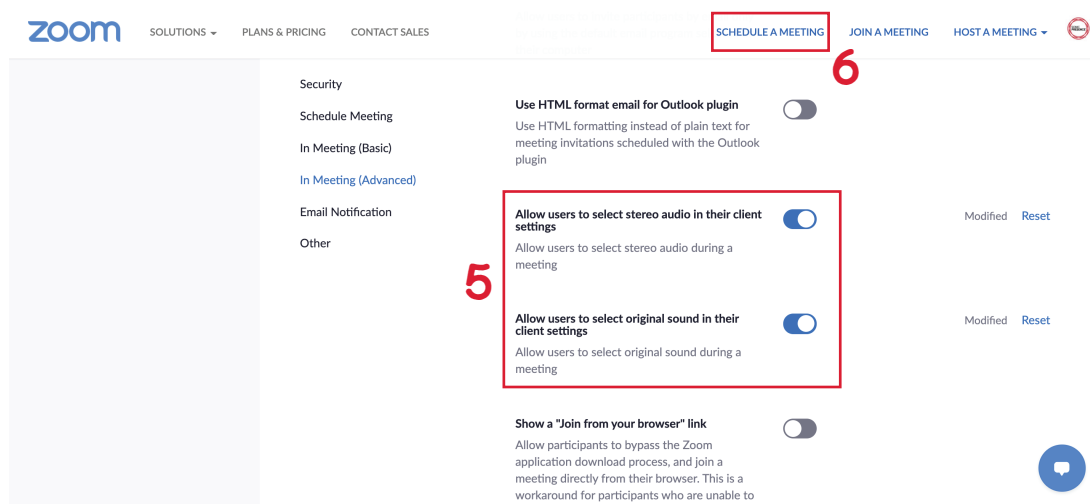
1. Go to **Zoom.us** in your web browser

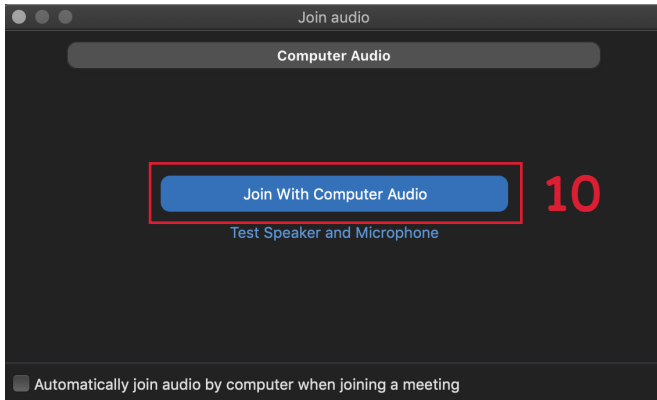

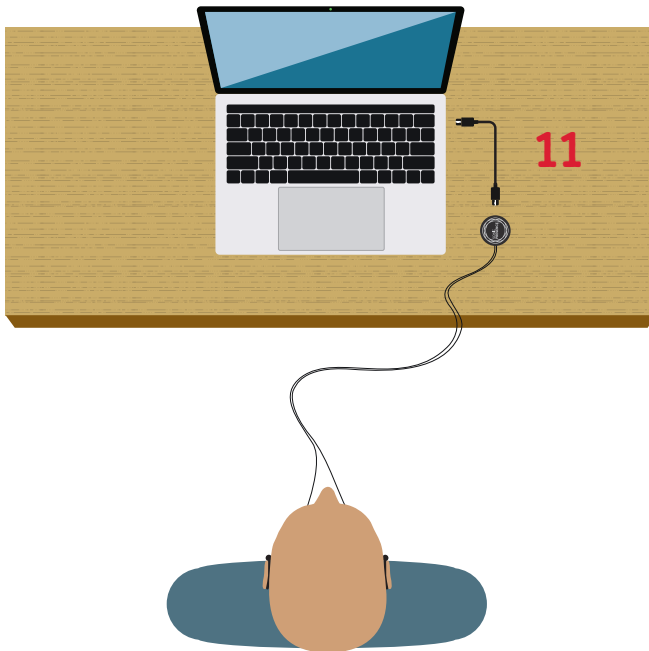

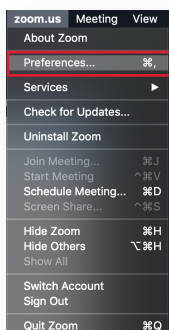
10. After the app automatically opens, click **Join With Computer Audio** to join the meeting.



11. Plug in your Sonic Presence SP15 Microphone using the USB-C plug.



12. Click **zoom.us** in your desktop navigation bar and go to **Preferences**.




11. Select **Audio**

12. Next to Microphone, select **SONIC PRESENCE SP-15 V2.0** from the dropdown menu.

13. Uncheck **Automatically adjust microphone volume**. Now adjust the input volume slider to raise or lower your voice.

14. Check all the boxes under **Music and Professional Audio**.
