

LEGAL RESTRICTIONS ON THE POSSESSION OF SABRE STUN GUNS

The possession and or sale of SABRE stun guns are legal in the vast majority of states and cities across the United States. However, a few states and cities have chosen to enact laws restricting in some way the possession and/or sale of stun guns. Listed below is the most current information on the states and cities with legal restrictions. There may be other states and cities with restrictions. Check your local laws to determine the legality of carrying a SABRE stun gun in your area. The end user must be 18 years of age to purchase. Don't take on Educational Property, Airports or Government Buildings.

THE FOLLOWING STATES HAVE RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF STUN GUNS, CHECK YOUR LOCAL LAWS FOR SPECIFIC RESTRICTSIONS:

- Iowa Need Permit or License to carry
- Illinois Must have a FOID card in possession at time of purchase, seller must keep a record of sale for 10 years, 24 hour waiting period to possess from time of purchase
- Georgia Can't take on Educational Property
- Maryland Background check is required, the seller must keep a record of buyers name
- Massachusetts 21 years or older to purchase, must have a Firearms ID card or a Firearms License to carry Firearms – NOT Legal for sale ONLINE
- Mississippi Must have a license to carry
- North Carolina Must keep on own private property
- Ohio Permit to carry might be required
- Wisconsin Must keep on own private property
- Connecticut Can't sell to convicted felons, people with mental illness, and must keep on own private property
- Minnesota Background check needed before purchase
- Oklahoma Permit to carry might be required
- South Dakota Can't sell to a convicted felon
