



Hearty Clay Miniature Frozen Yoghurt Tutorial from The MICROBAKERY



MINIATURE FROZEN YOGURT TUTORIAL
BY THE MICROBAKERY

1. PREPARE A PACK OF AIR DRY CLAY
2. CUT A LONG RECTANGLE FROM PAPER AND GLUE THE ENDS TOGETHER
3. PLACE A BASE LAYER OF CLAY IN THE BOTTOM OF THE CONTAINER. LET IT DRY.
4. FLIP CONTAINER UPSIDE DOWN AND GLUE BASE TO THE CONTAINER
5. USE A TOOL WITH KNURLING AND ROLL OVER POLYMER CLAY. CUT OUT A WEDGE SHAPE
6. SHADE THE EDGES WITH A BRUSH AND BROWN CHALK PASTELS, THEN BAKE
7. BAKE A CHUNK OF BROWN POLYMER CLAY THEN CUT IT INTO SMALL "CHOCOLATE CHIPS"
8. CREATE A STRAWBERRY SHAPE. CUT IT IN HALF. INDENT OUTSIDE WITH A NEEDLE. THEN BAKE.
9. THIN OUT ACRYLIC PAINT WITH WATER AND PAINT STRAWBERRIES
10. MAKE A PIPING BAG BY CUTTING THE CORNER OF A BAG AND TAPING ON THE ICING TIP
11. MAKE THE FROZEN YOGURT BY MIXING: AIR DRY CLAY, WATER, AND ACRYLIC PAINT
12. MIX UNTIL YOU GET A SMOOTH CONSISTENCY
13. PLACE MIXTURE INTO PIPING BAG AND CAREFULLY PIPE OUT A SWIRL
14. GLUE ON TOPPINGS AND LET EVERYTHING AIR DRY
