- **Step 1:** Carefully remove the vinyl decal from its paper backing by peeling off the transfer tape. The tape should retain all individual components of your decal design intact.
- **Step 2:** Position your decal on the desired surface, using the transfer tape to hold it in place. Ensure the alignment is just as you want it before proceeding to the next step.
- **Step 3:** Once satisfied with the decal's placement, firmly press the transfer tape onto the surface to make it stick.
- **Step 4:** Utilize a credit card to apply even pressure throughout the entire design. This will ensure the decal is fully adhered to the surface.
- **Step 5:** Gently peel off the transfer tape at a 180-degree angle, leaving the decal attached to the surface. Make sure to do this slowly to avoid damaging the decal.

Additional Note: If your decal design is particularly delicate, allow it to rest on the surface for a full 24 hours before peeling off the transfer tape. This additional time will enable the decal to bond more securely with the surface, facilitating the transfer tape removal while keeping the design intact.
