



## ADJUSTING THE BLADE FOR SHALLOWER CUTS

The Tomahawk Early Entry Concrete Saws' default blade setting is adjusted to the max blade depth of 1-3/16" (ASTM Standard Specification for Portland Cement). If a shallower cut is desired, follow these steps:

- **1)** Loosen the depth adjustment nut (1) above the front right wheel, counter-clockwise with a 13mm wrench.
- 2) Turn the depth stop adjustment bolt (2) clockwise with a Size 5 Metric Allen wrench. Each full revolution of the bolt will reduce the cut depth by 1/8".
- **3)** Make sure the rear wheels are flat on the ground by pushing down on the rear of the main frame.
- **4)** Follow an existing saw joint cut for approximately one foot to confirm that the proper/desired cut is achieved.
